School fees are payable by post-dated cheques at the time of registration. Field trip fees will be payable prior to the day of the trip.

Jamie's Preschool Society, a registered charitable organization, has been serving families from the Alberta Children's Hospital since 1986. Donations are gratefully accepted (receipts issued on request for donations of \$20 or more). As you know, Jamie's strives to help children and their families maintain some normalcy and improve quality of life during treatment and beyond, in hopes of bridging any gaps in learning and socialization that may result from their illness. We offer students an escape from the isolation of home and hospital—a chance to leave their troubles behind and just be kids for awhile. We're reminded of the importance of Jamie's every time we hear a child, who's been so dependent because of health issues, say to their parent, "You can leave now; I'm fine!" As we watch these kids enjoy normal early childhood experiences, happily playing with friends and learning new things, we know that together we are making a difference.

In order to better serve our fragile population, four years ago we made the leap to a dedicated, renovated, state-of-the-art facility. Costs have risen accordingly, while our fees have not increased since we opened in 1986! As we plan for the 2017-18 school year we are making some necessary adjustments.

Please know that no child who needs us will miss out on the opportunity to attend Jamie's. In respect of the increased financial burdens borne by families coping with chronic and acute childhood illness, we are prepared to consider accommodations on a case-by-case basis.
