April 4th I will be attending Tolles Tech in Plain City, Ohio to discuss Engineering and College to the Computer Engineering Technology program.


The Board of Governors will be awarding the Dr. Margaret Drake Scholarship at the April Board of Governors meeting.


We are also set for our September ASHRAE golf outing again this year. More info to come in the near future... Stay Tuned!
