Proceed westbound until you reach Sixth Line. Turn right. Head north for approximately two minutes. River Oaks Recreation Centre will be on your left.
From Hamilton/Niagara via QEW: Head east on the QEW until Trafalgar Road. Follow above instructions.
From the 407/403: Exit the 407 at the 403 Westbound toward Hamilton. Follow the 403 southbound. Exit at Dundas Street. Follow Dundas Street westbound toward Oakville. Go past Trafalgar Road. At Sixth Line, make a left turn. Travel one minute south and the recreation centre will be on your right.

Mandatory Equipment:

In accordance with Speed Skating Canada D3-100, all competitors must wear hard shell speed skating helmets, bib-style neck protectors, cut and water resistant gloves or mitts, knee pads, shin guards, shatter-resistant protective sport-glasses or a complete visor held in place by an elastic strap and long sleeve clothing are compulsory for all competitors. The back corners of the skate blades must be rounded off.
