PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT POINTS INFORMATION SHEET

NCCP Certified Speed Skating Coaches are required to obtain Professional Development (PD) points over a 5 year period to maintain their certification status.

- Fundamentals Coach – 10 PD points every 5 years
- Introduction to Competition – 20 PD points every 5 years
- Competition – Development - 30 PD points every 5 years
- ALL coaches must have completed Making Head Way in speed skating

PD points can be earned by participating in a variety of activities:

- National and Provincial sport organization conferences and workshops
- e-Learning modules
- NCCP workshops: sport specific or multi-sport
- Coach mentorship programs
- Active coaching declaration
- Participation on OSSA Coaching Committee

Point value is assigned per hour of workshop or course.

1 hour = 1 point

2 hours = 2 points

3+ hours = 3 points

Active coaching = 1 point per year

Coaches are responsible for maintenance of their certification and ensuring their transcripts are accurate in The Locker.
