Equipment:	In accordance with Speed Skating Canada regulation D3-100 in the SSC Red Book, all competitors must wear hard shell helmets, bib-style neck protectors, even if you are wearing a cut-proof suit, cut and water resistant gloves or mitts, knee protection, shin guards, ankle protection, and long sleeve clothing for this competition. The front and rear tips of skate blades must be rounded off and shatter-resistant protective sport glasses (clear or yellow) or a complete visor must be worn. Glasses must be held on by an elastic strap.			

The Bell Sensplex has asked that no large coolers of food be brought in the arena.

Athletes are welcome to bring their own food.
