- By Law 3.14 Voting Privileges - Members will have the following voting rights at all meetings of Members:
  - a) Member Clubs- will appoint a Delegate in accordance with Section 3.16, who may attend and participate in meetings and is entitled to one (1) vote for every 50 registered participants or part thereof, registered with the Member Club and the Association in accordance with section 3.15.
- By Law 3.15 Determination of Votes - The determination of votes for Annual General Meetings will be based on paid registered participants of the Member Club and disclosed to the Association as of the end of the previous fiscal year, and for any Special General Meeting will be based on paid registered participants of the Member Club and disclosed to the Association as of the date of notice of the Special General Meeting.
- By Law 3.16 Delegates – Each Member Club will appoint in writing (inclusive of electronic notice) to the Association, seven (7) days prior to the meeting of members, a Delegate to represent the Member Club. Delegates must be eighteen (18) years of age and older.
