## Holy Week

### *What the Holy Week Services Mean*

Holy Week began with Palm Sunday as Jesus rode triumphantly into Jerusalem and was greeted with praise, alleluias and the waving of palm branches. By Friday he is dead, crucified as a criminal.

### *Maundy Thursday*

*April 13<sup>th</sup> at 7pm*

Maundy Thursday we will be doing something new – a candlelight Tenebrae Service, which means “shadows.” Communion is at the heart of being a Disciple of Christ and this service focuses on the Lord’s table. We will witness the betrayal, abandonment, and agony of the events. The gradual extinguishing of light is symbolic of the flight of the disciples, the approach of enemies, and the suffering of Jesus. We wait in the darkness of the tomb for three days. Please consider joining us prior to the service for supper at the Weekly Community Meal at 5:30-6:30pm.
