And pray in the Spirit on all occasions with all kinds of prayers and requests. With this in mind, be alert and always keep on praying for all the saints. (Ephesians 6:18)

1. Please continue to pray for the addition of an English Service. May God grant unity and wisdom to the church and leaders. .

2. Pray for Rev. Spencer Wong who will lead a short-term mission team to Myammar in June, that they will have a safe and effective trip. Rev. Wong and his wife will then start to serve in Wellington Chinese Methodist Church, may God use them and provide all their need. Also pray for Rev. Chan of Auckland Chinese Methodist Church, that God will grant him sufficient strength to serve.

3. Give thanks for the small group bible study of Sermon on the Mount. We have been witnessing God's blessings and renewing in our fellowships. Also give thanks for the new small group material – Desiring God by John Piper. May the joy of the Lord be-

come our strength (Neh 8:10).

4. Continue to pray for adult baptism class. May God through His Holy Spirit of truth, grant saving faith and joy to those who attend the class, to be able to understand and

accept the truth of the gospel of the cross.

5. Pray to God to grant us at least 35 brothers and sisters who would participate in church building faith pledge with faithfulness. Each person will give NZD2000 for this year (NZD167/mth). May God raises prayers and givers to build a church which better serve Chinese migrant families.

6. Pray to God to prepare for us a suitable pastor for the English congregation.

7. Pray for the Equipping the Saints ministry, may God build even more brothers and sisters to be disciples who humbly seek spiritual growth, and able to witness for Christ with mission and power of the Spirit.

8. Pray for who are awaiting delivery sisters (Chloe Tai, Catherine Tie, Linny Wong) and those who has just given birth (Shirley Chang and Ching Ping Liew), may God grant good health to mothers and babies, and may God's peace and joy be with them.

9. Pray for the installation of screen and sound in back hall lounge. Although we face some challenges in the process, may God guide us and grant us wisdom, so that the mothers taking care of the little ones in the back hall may worship and listen to sermon with the brothers and sisters in the chapel.

10. Pray for junior youths on Sundays, may God grant us wisdom, that we know how to help them to have worship, fellowship and teaching of truth.

11. Pray for Guinea, with population of over 10 millions, 88% are Muslims, 4% are Christians, and among them only 0.7% are evangelicals. Thank God that there are signs of strong unity, strategic coordination among the foreign mission groups, and a small indigenous mission movement has also been established. The Church suffered serious numerical setbacks in the late 1990s and early 2000s. Some established denominations shrank significantly, and evangelism and church planting slowed – probably largely due to nominal Christians falling away. Pray for believers

who will persevere, and pray against the enemy who seeks to destroy these young or

weak Christians.

Meditation: Westminster Shorter Catechism

Q. 14. What is sin?

A. Sin is any want of conformity unto, or transgression of, the law of God.

Pastor's Sharing:

"Whatever you ask in my name, this I will do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son. If you ask me anything in my name, I will do it." (John 14:13-14)

What actually makes our prayers heard and answered by God? The Name of Jesus Christ, God's son.

There are at least two aspects worthy of our reflections and meditation:

1. Apart from Jesus Christ's name, what other things do we rely on so that our prayers can be heard by God? Is it your tone? Is it your posture? Do we also use such things to judge others whether their prayers are 'spiritual'? Is absolute fasting more effective than partial fasting? Does kneeling down make your prayers more favorable than praying sitting down?

Lord Jesus says pray in His name, this is so that we know that we are absolutely unqualified, and we are totally incapable of doing anything to make our prayers heard. Of course, fasting and kneeling down are good ways to help us concentrate and pouring out our thoughts before God, yet there are absolutely no merit in themselves.

It is by the grace and merit of the cross of God's Son Jesus Christ alone, and because of His identity as our only mediator and great high priest, that when we humbly pray with faith in His Name, our prayers are heard by God. This Name is God's glory.

2. Is Jesus' name a magic word, which make whatever we ask for granted? If this is our understanding, we do not know Jesus' Name at all. For if we know what God in Christ's name elected us according to His sovereign will, loves us, accepts us, cleanse us and making us a new creation, we will not pray taking Christ's name in vain and profane His holy name. When we pray in Christ Jesus' name, we will comprehend Jesus' will in redeeming us, we will pray after His own prayers, we will hallow God's name, we will pray for God's will to be done, we will be willing to do God's will, for this Name is God's glory.

Therefore in as 'little thing' as a prayer, it is worthy for us to examine ourselves, whether we are truly 'Scripture alone, Christ alone, grace alone, faith alone, and glory to God alone'.

Gospel:

Recently a movie came out about the end of



the world. It is titled "2012". It is based upon the fact that the Mayan calendar ends in December 2012. Will the world really end on that date? Many people seem to think so and their numbers are growing. Movies about the end of the world come out every once in a while. Is there really any need for concern though? Well, according to the Bible, the world WILL end at some point in time. Jesus said that only the Father knows the day or the hour when the end will come. The most important question is what will happen when the end comes? According to the Bible, Judgment Day will be next. God will judge each person by His Law according to how each person has lived. God will judge your thoughts, words and deeds. The Bible says that all those who have lied, looked with lust, had sex before marriage, been drunk, taken God's name in vain, stolen, or hated will be cast into Hell on Judgment Day. Which ones apply to you? Or do they all apply to you?! You have every reason to fear the end of the world if you get what you deserve for your sins!

The good news is that God has provided a way for you to be forgiven of your sins and brought back into a right relationship with Him. God loved his people enough to send His Son to die as a sacrifice for our sins. If you will repent of your sins (turn from them) and trust in what Jesus did on the cross, you can be forgiven of your sins and reconciled to God. Your sins have separated you from God, so you need to forsake them and walk in holiness through an intimate relationship with God. Forget about "2012"! Will you survive Judgment Day? Get right with God before it is too late!
