AMAZING RUMMAGE SALE!!!

At our Fall Rummage Sale our profit was \$8,619.88 and the profit from our Spring Sale was \$9,428.27, for a total of \$18,048.15. omen's Auxiliary uses this money very carefully. All of the nice white rectangular tables you see were purchased with money from our sales. This year we replaced the broken coffee pot in the kitchen. In years past our funds have purchased the ice machine (and kept it working) and the convection oven. We've also refurbished the kitchen and the women's bathroom. Women's Auxiliary's contribution to the General Fund of the church depends on our sales. This year we donated \$7,000. Two years ago we were able to donate \$8,000. We also donate to the Library and the Music Department and help send our kids to the NAPF National Meeting and provide Cedar Lake Camperships.

Our Outreach Budget it \$2,500. Locally, we donate to Inland Valley Hope Partners, Foothill Family Shelter, House of Ruth, Pomona Police Dept. Crime Prevention, Children of the Night, and Mercy House. We also help support the Pan American Institute in Tijuana, projects in Haiti and Kenya, and an orphanage in Kenya.

So you can see how important our sales are. We thank you so much for all you do to help make them happen. We are taking donations. You can bring your rummage to the garage on Thursday and Sunday mornings, or leave it in the Gym whenever the Office is open.
