THE SEVEN LOST RANCHOS OF OUR INLAND VALLEY

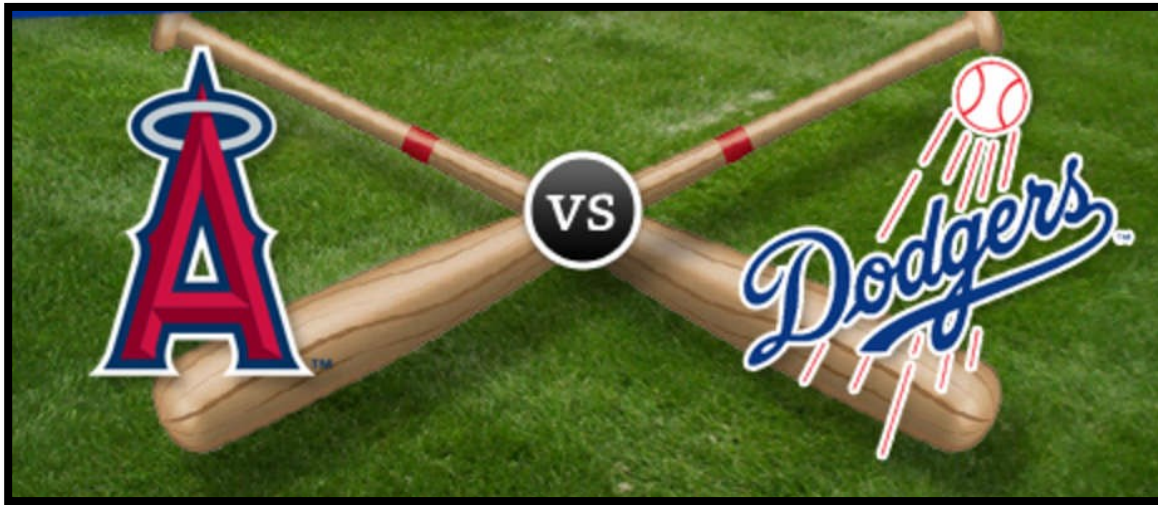

JULY LIBRARY NEWS

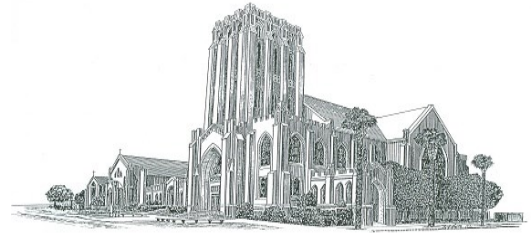
