THE 100 CLUB DOES JUST THAT



The TSS 100 Club has been set up to fund the purchase of boats and blades in addition to those already budgeted for within TSS.

In 2013 the TSS 100 Club had raised sufficient funds to buy a new Wintech quad named *100 Club*. Before it even left Nottingham Alan Campbell used this boat at the 2013 British Rowing Championships and it has since been used for racing and training by all but the lightest TSS squads.



More recently in January 2017 a set of C2 Skinny Sweep Smoothies was purchased and christened by the Senior Women's IM1 crew 'Netflix' in the Quintin Head.



Joining the 100 Club is easy. Just set up a standing order. It is open to anyone over the age of 18 years. The prize draws are quarterly and drawn from the funds received in the quarter. Tickets cost £3 each and therefore you will need to set the standing order up in multiples of £3 every 3 months or monthly (1 ticket = £3, 2 tickets = £6, 3 tickets = £9 etc).

All details of the lottery are posted on the TSS website.

- 50% of all proceeds raised go to the TSS 100 Fund for purchasing additional blades and boats.
- 50% is distributed in the form of prizes to the value of £50, £25, or £10 if your ticket is drawn.
