## PERICLES GREEK SCHOOL PARENT AND STUDENT EXPECTATIONS

It is important that Students, Parents and Staff work together and abide by general guidelines stated in the school handbook, to make the school year productive and enjoyable for everyone. We trust that students and parents together will meet the following expectations during the school year.

□ BRING YOUR CHILDREN TO SCHOOL ON TIME: Our time with your children is limited, and therefore precious. Late arrivals are disruptive to the class and are disrespectful to the instructors. Please have your children at least five minutes before the start of school. This will allow your child to settle in. Students who arrive late must report to the Director who will escort them to class. Unless a teacher is notified of exceptional circumstances in advance, students arriving to school ten minutes after the commencement of class will be marked tarty.
□ SCHOOL DISCIPLINE:
It is expectation of all that the classroom be a safe environment for learning. Student behavior should not be disruptive to the teaching and learning process, or jeopardize the health and safety of anyone. Students who engage in such conduct will receive a warning, second their parents will be notified. After that students and parents will meet with the Director and teacher.
□ PICK UP YOUR CHILDREN AT DISMISSAL TIME:
Our staff has other commitments after the duty day; let's respect that and pick up your children within 10 minutes after the dismissal time.
☐ MAKE SURE YOUR CHILD COMPLETES THE HOMEWORK: Homework is an important tool in reinforcing the lesson. Studies show that students who review their work from school do far better than those who do not. If you do not understand the homework assignment, please email or call the teacher. Obtain homework by contacting the teacher when absent.
COMMUNICATE WITH YOUR CHILD'S TEACHER:  It is important to be involved with your child's progress. Teachers will provide their email address on the first day of school. If you have concerns, please let the teacher know. We want to make learning Greek as a second language enjoyable for the child. We are here to help navigate this experience with you. Conferences with the teachers are held annually in November and if a parent feels an additional conference is needed or has a concern; please arrange a time to meet with the teacher. Together we can make it a successful school year!
□ SNOW DAYS/SCHOOL CLOSING: In the event of schools closing due to inclement weather, the Pericles Greek School will inform all parents via email or a phone call. Also, we will post it on our website.
□ SUPPORT THE SCHOOL ACTIVITIES: We welcome parental involvement in our Greek School program. During the special Greek School celebrations, our PTO will ask you to volunteer. Please do so. We know we can always count on our parents to stay involved.
