What a USC Observer does.

One observer is assigned to each team vessel for a full day of competition on May 5th and/or 6th. Competition hours both days are 7am - 4pm. All Observers will first be trained in the following areas.

- Observer Guidelines
- Species Identification
- > Best Practice Catch & Release Procedures
- Tagging and Documentation
- > USC Rules and Regulations

We appreciate your interest in participating as a Certified USC Observer Volunteer in this innovative angling format designed to meet the combined goals of sport, science and conservation. All Observers must be at least 18 years of age and are required to submit a completed application.

Some fishing experience is recommended. Applicants should not be prone to seasickness, and must be physically capable of carrying out the required tasks, while sharing a desire to promote responsible recreational fishing and the conservation of our marine resources.

Applicants are urged to visit the tournament website at www.TheUltimateSharkChallenge.com to familiarize themselves with the event and its format. Observer eligibility will be made based on a variety of factors including, but not limited to information provided on this application form. All applications will be accepted, reviewed and considered by tournament staff. In some cases, further communications may be requested. The USC reserves the right to approve or deny any applicatant.

Upon review, applicants will be contacted by a USC Tournament Director and notified whether or not they've been accepted into the program. Before receiving an event assignment, accepted applicants must successfully attend a free training session held the afternoon of May 4th at the tournament location in Punta Gorda between the hours of 4pm and 7pm.

Individuals who successfully attend and complete the training session will be designated a certified 'USC Observer'. Required items will be provided by the USC.
