

## Disabling Hard Disk Quota's V 1.00

*Product:* Windows 2003 Server  
*Situation:* Disabling Disk Quota's  
*Symptoms:* User's cannot save anymore files to a particular network folder.  
*Check:* Disk Capacity, Disk Free Space.  
*Causes:* Disk Quota's are enabled

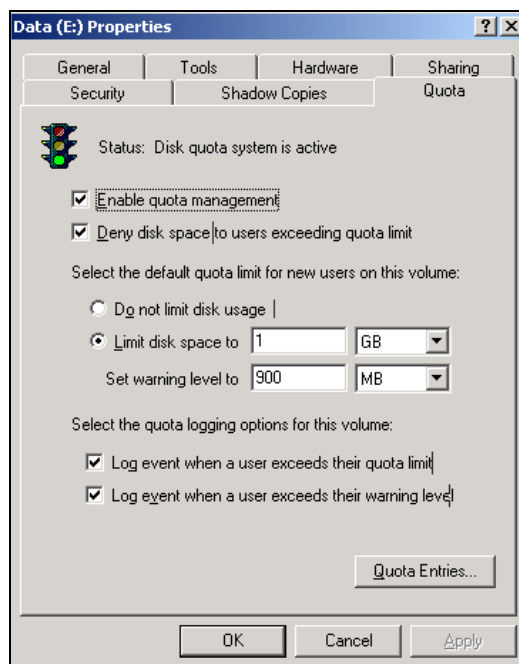
### Solutions:

By default SBS 2003 has disk user disk quota enabled. In cases where users exceed these limits they will typically receive a disk full error. To overcome this issue you can simply disable the disk quotas on the physical hard disk which is causing the issue.

You can disable disk quotas at any point. Users will not be required to logout or save files. Also the server will not require a reboot.

To disable disk quotas

1. Go to the SBSERVER and login as administrator or a user with administrator privileges.
2. Open **Windows Explorer**.
3. Right Click the physical drive you are having issues with. In most cases this will be **Data E:**. May be C: on some smaller sites.
4. Select **Properties**
5. Select the **Quota** Tab.



6. Untick **Enable quota management**
7. Click **OK**
8. Click **OK** to confirm that you want to disable disk quota's.
