

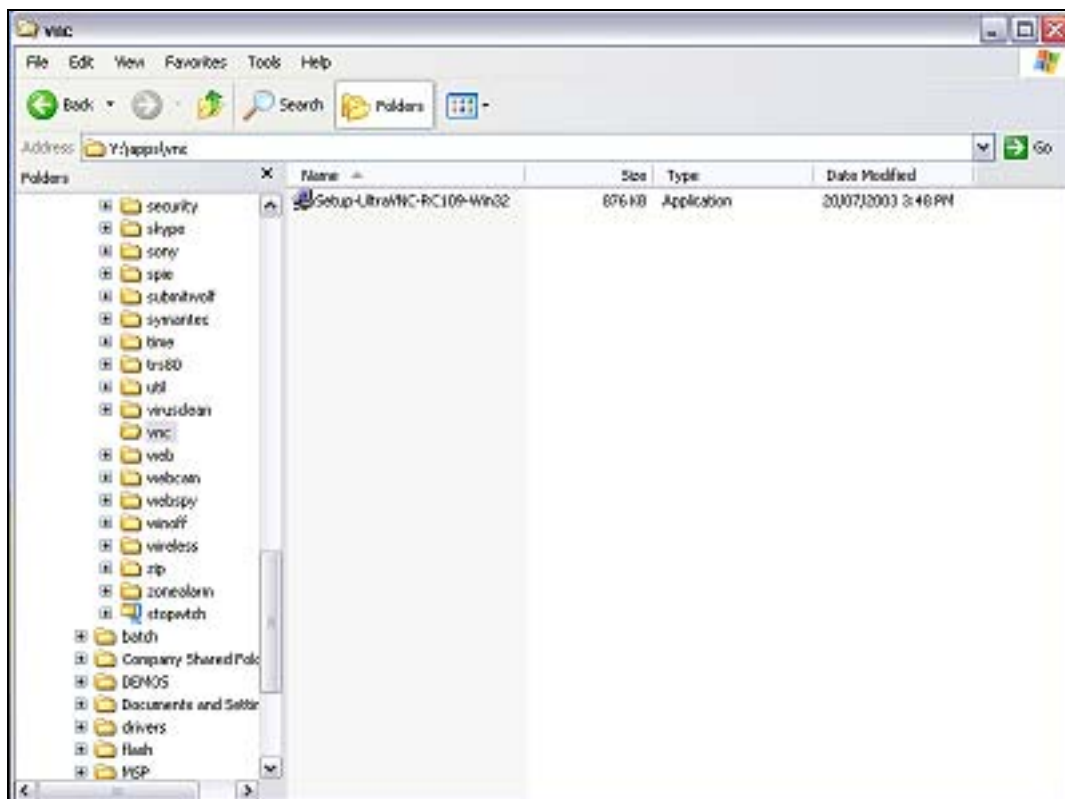
## Installing VNC on a workstation Version 1.00

VNC is an open source program that allows you to take control of a remote workstation. VNC requires two components for operation a “viewer” and “server”. Both of these programs are contained in a single installer package.

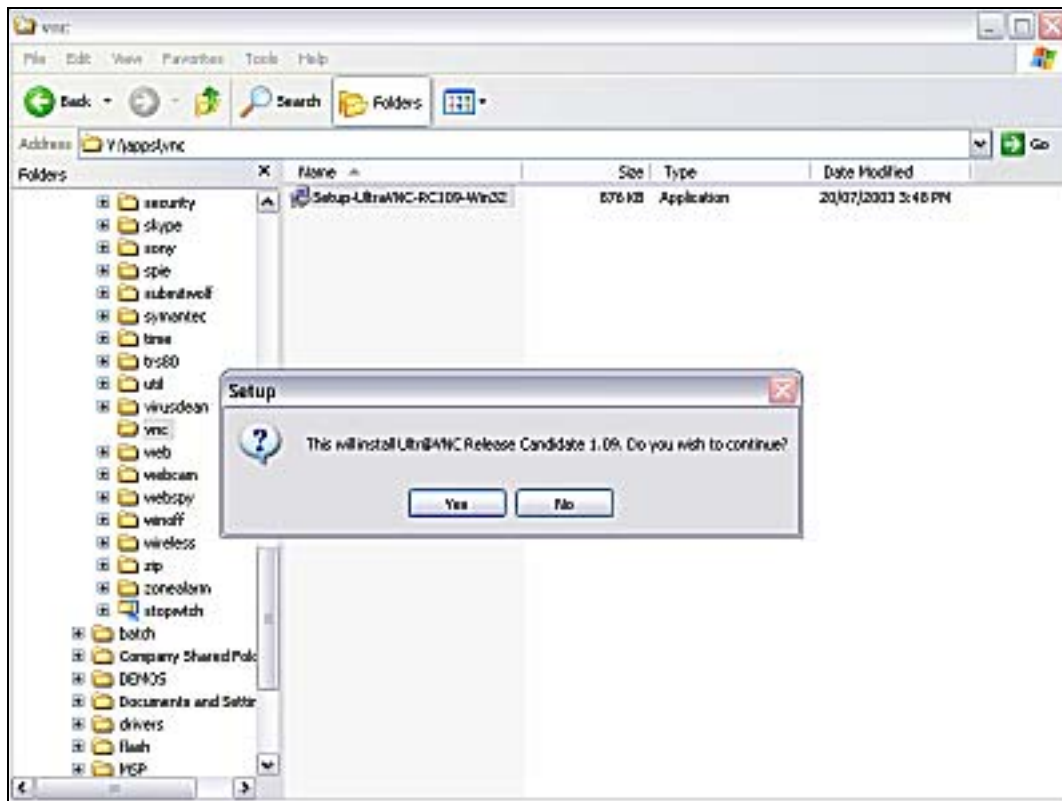
1. To install VNC download the VNC package from the Internet and store on your server or workstation. You can find it at :

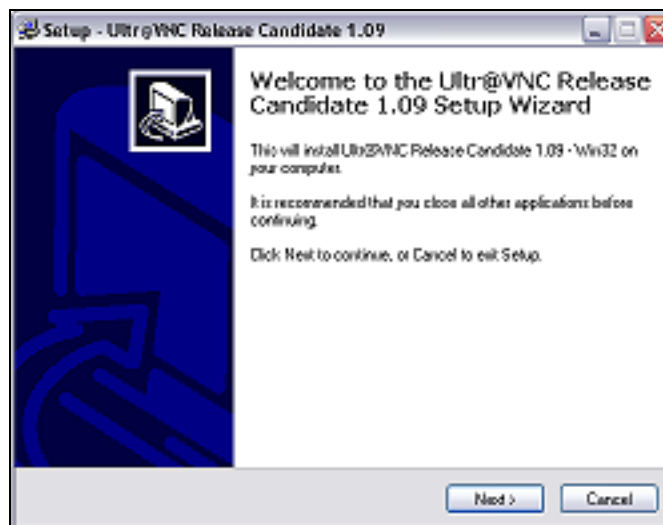
2. Locate the VNC package on your computer and simply double-click on the program that you downloaded.



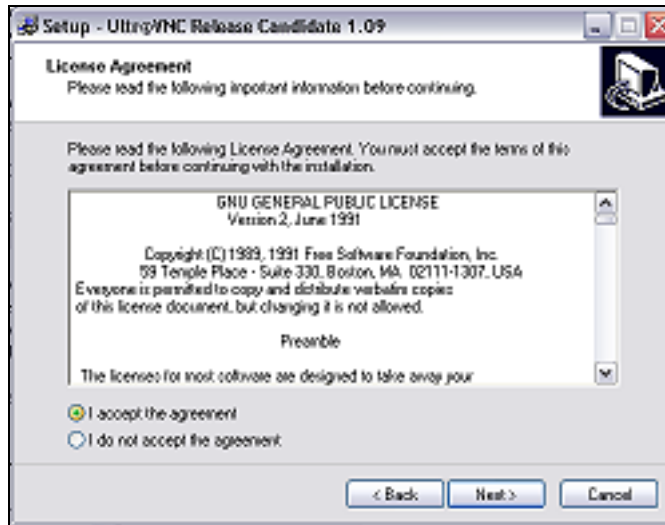
3. You will now be prompted as to whether you wish to install VNC. Select **Yes** to continue.



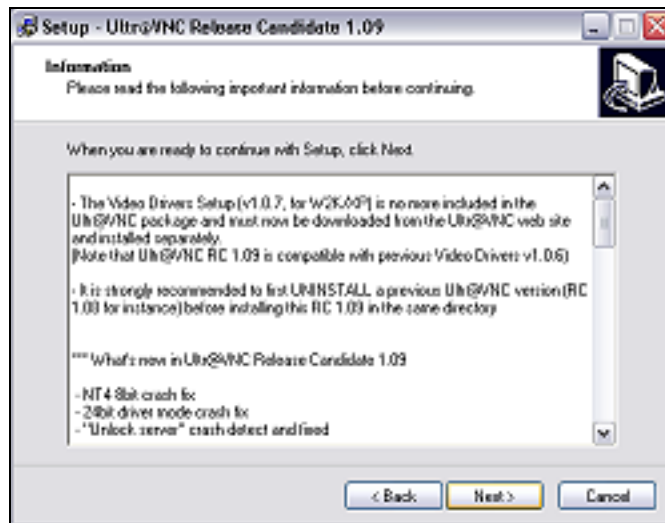
4. You will now see the installation wizard commence. To continue the installation select the **Next** button.



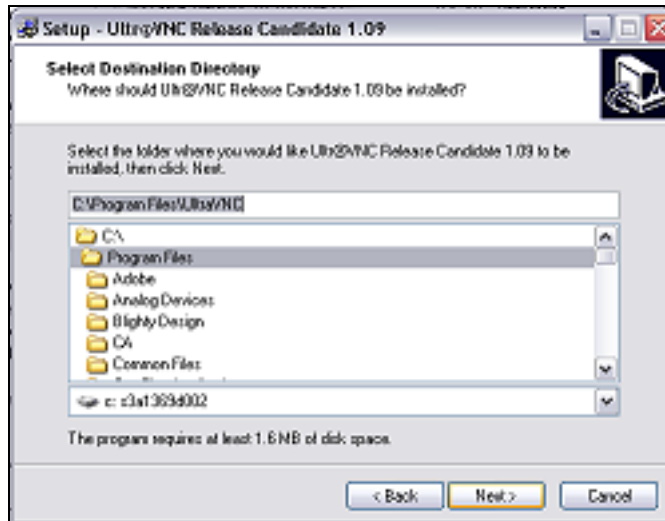
5. You will now be presented with the license screen. Select **I accept the agreement** and press the **Next** button. You can't proceed with the installation unless you select the **I accept** option



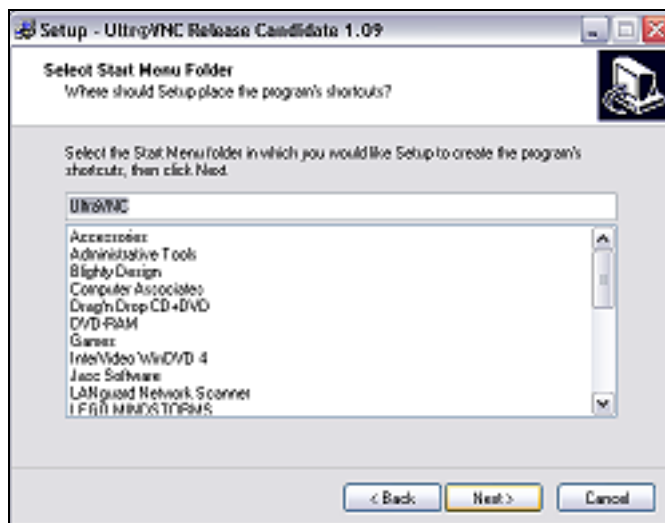
6. You will now see an information screen. Press **Next** to proceed.



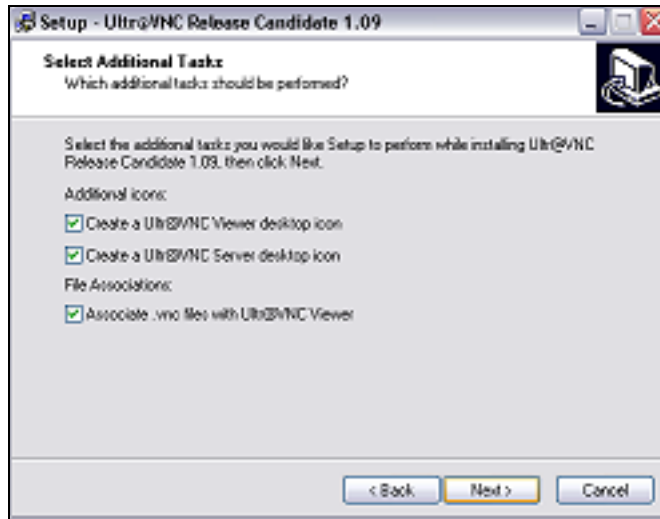
7. You will now be prompted as to where you wish to install the programs. In most cases the default location is fine. If you wish to make a change, enter the new location. When ready press the **Next** button to proceed.



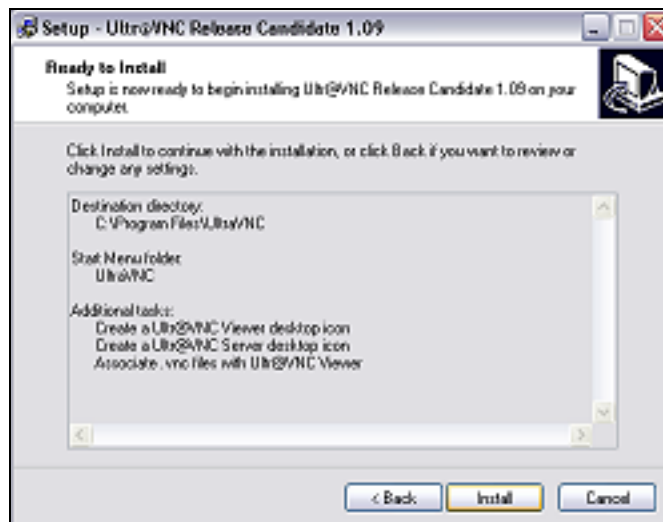
8. Next you will be prompted for a name to call the program group. The default option is usually ok. Press the **Next** button to proceed.



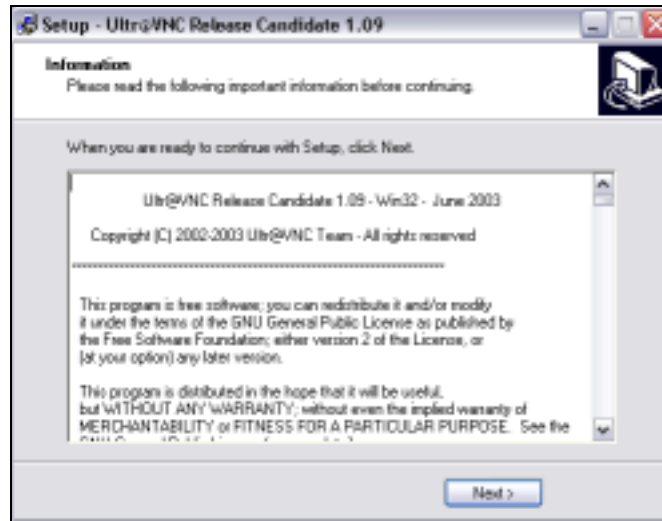
9. You will now see a number of check box options. These will simply create icons for the VNC viewer and server on your desktop as well as associating .VNC files with the VNC program. You can change the defaults if you wish. When ready press **Next** to continue.



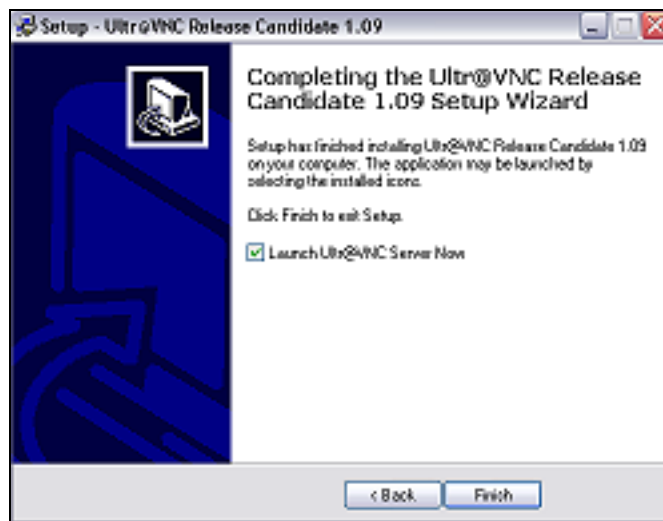
10. The next screen will show you a summary of the installation options that you have chosen. Select Install to continue with the software installation.



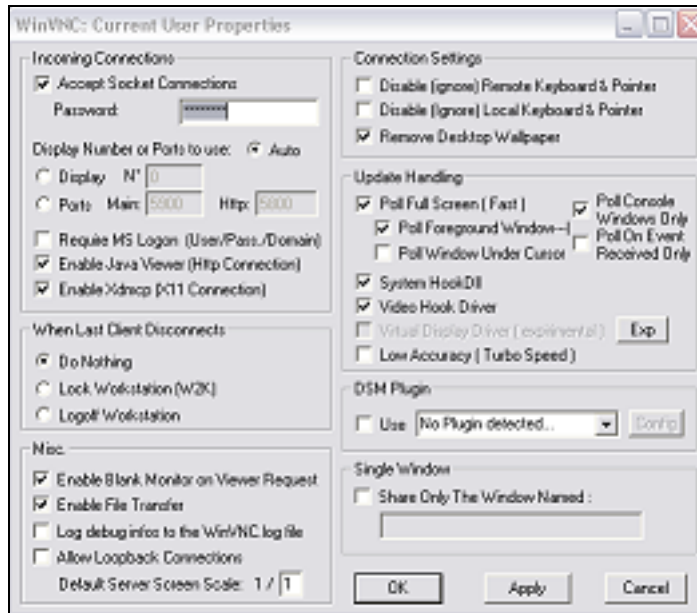
11. The installation will briefly copy files onto your workstation. When complete you should see the following screen indicating a successful installation. You can read the information about the VNC product here. Press the **Next** button when ready to proceed.



12. You should now see the following screen that will complete the VNC installation on your machine. There is a checkbox option to determine whether you wish to run the VNC server program directly after the completion of the VNC installation. You may unselect this if you wish to run VNC at a later stage. At this point we will leave selected and press the **Finish** button.



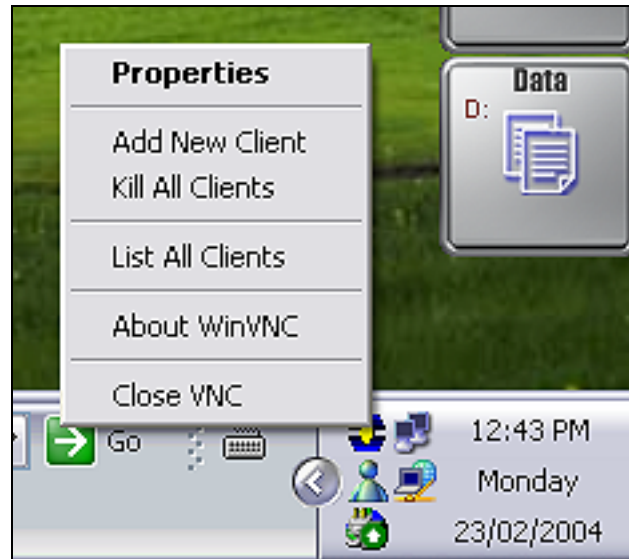
13. Once the installation is complete and if you selected the check box to Launch VNC server you will be presented with the following screen. To enable VNC server on the machine simply enter a password into the top left of the screen and select **OK**.



14. When you select **OK** the VNC server screen will disappear. In the system tray in the lower right of the computer you will see a small VNC icon indicating the server program is running and ready to accept remote clients.



15. You can close VNC server simply by right mouse clicking on the VNC icon in the system tray and selecting **Close VNC**.



16. If you close VNC server and wish to run it again, simply double click on the VNC server icon that appears on the desktop or navigate to VNC server via the Start | Programs menu.
