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Prologue

Is it fair in the prologue to make a confession, to “confess” here about all of the ugly things that I have lived through, or to discuss all that I have perpetrated on myself or on others over the years? If so, who knows, maybe I will seek confession here. Actually, “Do I need to confess at all?” is the question I should be asking myself. You see I know that God is the only reason I have been allowed to arrive at this juncture in my life, living it as I now do.

What you are about to read is a message from God. A message that requires you to understand that a part of what you have been doing in your desire to know Him is fine. The missing parts are what this message is about. For some of you, you may be too far along a given Path to understand what is being said here; and for some you may assume you know better and can rebuke these words to fit into ideals, or mans created ideology.

We all have had our problems with religion be it our own or someone else’s, but that is not what this book is about. It is about a message that I have been carrying with me for 65 years. I have finally come to a point where I can have it come out to the public. *I must say here that it is the truth—like it or not.* Personally I could care less as it has been given to me and my responsibility was to give it to you, so now I give it to you. Please remember one other thing here...I am the writer only, not the Author.

This book is what God wants of you now. You need to learn this and come to understand it as His message. A message for you to finally understand how your life is to be lived while here in His Garden. The Garden is what we all call Earth. It is about Karma, and Reincarnation, and how mankind has let it slip through the cracks. Because living in belief of these actions / beliefs allows man to live a more harmonious life with his fellow man. When followed it would stop a need for separate divinations from the testaments concerning the future of mankind.

Imagine having information that says we are all in this together, and we all return to repeat the process unless we make changes in our lives concerning the welfare of our brethren and ourselves. This is what this message is about, ***“The object lesson here is to accept karma and reincarnation and live your life as Christ did. To “prevent” your return from happening.”*** Also, know that God is the purest form of incarnate.

Here is just one reason to believe in reincarnation. Because if you do not, than you cannot believe that the Lord / Jesus has come. A side note here. I once asked a Methodist reverend if he believed in Jesus Christ and the fact that He has come as Prophesized. He said yes of course. Which of course is the answer I expected. I than asked did he believe in reincarnation. Or is there even a need to believe in reincarnation if you’re a Christian? His answer was no. He felt that a belief in reincarnation had no place in Christianity. I than asked if he knew where in the bible that Jesus said that a reincarnation had taken place. His reply was that it had not happened. I quipped that in order for him to believe in Jesus Christ as coming and fulfilling the prophecy he had to believe in reincarnation. See this is fact. **The prophecy of the return of Elijah appears in the last verses of your Old Testament, in the book of the prophet Malachi 3, 1; 4, 5-6: “See,**

I will send you the prophet Elijah before that great and dreadful day of the Lord comes.”

Jesus Christ proclaims himself that John the Baptist is said to be the reincarnation of the prophet Elijah. In Matthew 11:14, Jesus says: *“And if you are willing to accept it, he (John the Baptist) is the Elijah who was to come.”* In the same Gospel, while answering the apostles about the coming of Elijah, Jesus told them: *“But I tell you, Elijah has already come, and they did not recognize him, but have done to him everything they wished. In the same way the Son of Man is going to suffer at their hands.”* The commentary adds: *“Then the disciples understood that he was talking to them about John the Baptist.”* (Matthew 17:12-13; see also Mark 9:12-13).

In these passages, Jesus affirms that reincarnation is truth, that there among them walk the non-believers in Him as well, which is why they did not understand that if John the Baptist was not the reincarnated Elijah, how could they accept Jesus as God incarnate? For in order for Jesus to be accepted as the Son of God our Lord who has come for mankind Elijah had to declare His return, as the Old Testament declared.

This is the reason why I must write this book; Christianity—Karma and Reincarnation—is not for me to know alone, but for you, to understand that this is your last gift from God.

Here is also another passage in Matthew 24:34-35

*34 Verily I say unto you, **this generation shall not pass, till all these things be fulfilled.** 35 Heaven and earth shall pass away, but my words shall not pass away.*

Those none believers who lived at that time will continue to be re-born until they come to Jesus. Until they accept Him for whom He is and will be forever. For He is the Son of God!

I have personally wrestled with the notion that all of my early experiences concerning this message, and my relationship with God were conceived by me because of my quality of life. However there have always been certain times in my relationship with God that screamed at me that I had to complete this task for Him, starting at birth. There are those incidents that have happened in my life that I should not have lived through, and there are those things that I was told would happen by a messenger of God, and they actually did happen!

So now what do I do? Knowing me, I must ask myself constantly, *“Am I a reflection, a mirror of what is wrong with mankind?”* And, as I write this message, is some of this ugliness splashing on me like dark red paint making me want to shrink into some shell? Am I seeing me when I write?

No. I know that is not happening because as bad as I may have been at times I am still a babe in the woods compared to the atrocities man has inflicted upon one another over the centuries. So what is it then that makes me wonder *“Why me?”* Then I stop wondering as I write the message because I get this feeling of Grace as it comes over me like a blanket, and all thoughts or doubts about the message leave me immediately.

Comfort and love fills me and words flow—thoughts—ideas and knowledge hidden from man for centuries come to the fore and I pass over this with ease; I can see things clearly as if on a big screen, and it makes sense the next line of words I write. The three books it has taken me to write His message allows me to tell you what I have seen mankind go from and enter into.

“What does not make sense is the ugliness that I see inflicted on man by man. What does not make sense is the despair I see and the horror we have made for each other. Knowing that for some people they think so what.”

These are things that make me feel inept when I am not writing—things that could not be happening to man. *“I have to be making this up in my mind,”* I say to myself. But no, my punishment must be that I am forced to live in both the real world, and this world of Grace, I must mingle amongst both the ugly and the beautiful in order to see and understand Gods message.

Then I think, *“Is this message even meant to be read and followed now? Or after the reconstruction of man will someone lead mankind by these very words?”*

Because, if we do not follow our Path’s correctly as God so instructed us, then reconstruction is our fate! Unless God makes the other decision, which is:
