You'll need to read this with a renewed mind and spirit. This comes only through Jesus, supernaturally.

# CHAPTER 1 FIRE AND HAMMERS: The power of the gospel



Our prayer is that Western congregations grow up strong and mighty in what Holy Spirit wants for us that we might be fire and light to the world in the increasing darkness.

Our experience is that many of those in Western churches—and I particularly remember the one I grew up in—think of "going to church" as a lovely obligation that keeps one on the right path. There often is something good to do, like teach Sunday school or sing in the choir, the latter of which I did when I was growing up.

But neither in that church I grew up in nor in any

church we've attended as adults were there altar calls.

Does YOURS have altar calls?

("Is this important?" you may ask.)

For me, personally, it is grieving. Had I been given the plan of salvation as a child I would have been saved as a child, and I probably would not have experienced the anguish I did growing up because someone would have taught me Deuteronomy 28. Most likely, I would have learned early on how to walk in blessing.

I would have had a supernatural heart change in the 50s instead of in 1984. (Please see Ezekiel 36:26-27.)

And I offer a yes and amen and yes and amen to all my siblings in the Kingdom because we each and all are called to be soul winners! It wasn't until we became aware of Drs. Rodney and Adonica Howard-Browne's *Great Awakening* on CTN every night live at 7:30 that we received our own epiphanies regarding the fact that every single believer not only *should* be a soul winner in these last days, but that every single believer *can* be.

every night, while it is still on.

Not only did we receive the loving conviction that we needed to get out of our prayer closets and win souls, but we saw every night how the signs, wonders, and healings that many of us long for pour out through the soul winners to the new believers! Watch and be amazed!

The Howard-Brownes have a church that is actually growing on a regular basis through altar calls and new believers. Growing weekly, the church sends the new people out to work in the harvest field.

They grow up to be as bold as lions and soar like eagles, in His Name and Grace (Proverbs 28:1 and Isaiah 40:31).

Yes, people are experiencing the Holy Fire of Heaven burning out the diseases and soulish separations from God so they then can experience joy and peace and commissioning from Heaven.

(My soulish separations included agoraphobia, manic-depression, alcoholism, a smoking addiction, hate, and unforgiveness.)

Heaven's fire and Holy Spirit took it all out of me

immediately when I was saved in 1984. Praise God! (Please see Matthew 3:11 and Luke 3:16.)

The Great Awakening uses something they call the gospel script since it was given to them from Holy Spirit during their Good News New York crusade in the summer of 1999 when Madison Square Garden was filled with hungry souls for six weeks and over 46,000 gave their lives to Yeshua Jesus.

It is a small piece of paper one can fit in one's pocket that is <u>read</u> to those who are lost from His love.

The Scripture in it - the very power of God - moves on the souls and spirits of those reached out to who resist, whose hearts then melt under the power and supernatural love of the Word.

The stony heart is broken up with the hammer of the Word (Jeremiah 23:29; Ezekiel 36:26). Thousands have received Jesus as Lord and Savior through *The Great Awakening* team.

### Our Own Churches Growing in Signs, Wonders, and Miracles

We often pray for the Western Church:

O Abba, Your mercy and grace are huger than the galaxies.

You've put laminin into us to hold us together, and made our spirits sit with You in high places. (Ephesians 2:6)

We are but specks in the universe, at best. Yet You know and care for every hair on each of our heads.

(Luke 21:18; Matthew 10:30-31)

Help us, huge and mighty Abba Father, be huger, like You, and love everyone, helping You turn flocks and herds into those soaring like eagles, bold as lions.

Perhaps the best way to describe what we see as the

lack of Heaven's fire in many churches is the following: We had a church leader tell us recently that we had to be careful not to invite Holy Spirit in too much, or we wouldn't be able to handle Him.

Another leader said we needed to experience Him "through the prism" of a certain denomination.

My husband and I experienced what asking Holy Spirit to be in charge looks like in the prayer group we were leading; however, as we prayed for leadership, it was difficult to see what a <u>congregation</u> would look like with Holy Spirit in charge.

Not to mention in denominations with unique traditions driving the weekly services!

But then we began to see how it's done through John Kilpatrick's Church of His Presence at http://www.churchofhispresence.org and also at the Brownes' River Church at http://www.revival.com.

One can watch and then learn how to encourage Holy Spirit to lead one's services.

The pastors and evangelists at these two churches recognize the imperative to decrease their own presence and words for the power of God to be manifested in the services.

Such services draw in the lost world.

Our prayer is that Western congregations grow up strong and mighty in what Holy Spirit wants for us that we might be fire and light to the world in the increasing darkness.

Surely our Father Abba, who placed all the stars in the heavens, knows them each individually, and sits high above the galaxies, is absolutely boundless in His desire for us to acquire all that He has already given us.

He knows every one of our names!

Is He not sending the Hubble telescope pictures <u>just to show His grandeur</u> to us to provoke us to cry out for His power and fire and glory that we all need to reach the lost? Not by might, but by His Spirit? (Zechariah 4:6)

Our question is, "Are we grieving Him, Holy Spirit - the God who is with us down here - by not asking Him for His fullness for us all? Are we grieving Him by not asking Him for the Fire and Light from Heaven?" (Ephesians 4:30)

Jesus commanded His disciples to "tarry." "Behold, I send the Promise of My Father upon you; but tarry ye in

the city of Jerusalem until ye be endued with power from on high" (Luke 24:49).

We have seen little insistence in churches we've visited to guide the flock to tarry -- to stop and wait until Holy Spirit comes to lead.

My husband and I have personally experienced we must yield every fiber of our beings to Him in order for Holy Spirit to change us so that we are given more heavenly supernatural fire and light to be used to draw others into a hunger and thirst to have their own saving, healing, relationship with Jesus.

When we as individuals and as congregations seek His leading, Holy Spirit changes our priorities.

We suddenly are more holy and fruitful. Salvations and miracles manifest.

Why aren't we asking for the baptism that Jesus baptized with - Holy Spirit and fire? (Matthew 3:11)

Wouldn't we then be given the supernatural power to bring more lasting spiritual fruit into our ministries and missions to our families, neighborhoods, towns, cities, regions, and countries?

Why aren't churches bursting at the seams with new,

enthusiastic believers?

Isn't this what every church and church member wants?

Jesus Himself needed our Holy Spirit to walk out His ministry (See the 4th chapter of Matthew, as well as Matthew 3:16.)

Paul and Silas and the other fathers and mothers of us all needed Holy Spirit to walk out *their* missions.

Abba Father sent Him to them (John 14:26) in His Son's Name.

We wonder why we have never heard teaching on this locally in the churches we have visited.

We also wonder if there is a seminary anywhere that is dedicated to knowing this God within us, Holy Spirit.

We found one, the River Bible Institute, at Revival.com!

### Congregations and Our Holy Spirit

Of course, everyone knows the disciples didn't have congregations to ask about the deeper matters of God.

In countries where salvations are exploding, new

believers are not generally raised up to be part of denominations. Instead, they rise up to bear spiritual fruit as they live out of God's supernatural Kingdom, like Moses and Joseph.

People are called all over the world by the ministry of Holy Spirit in places where there are no churches, television ministries, or Bibles. Once they receive Holy Spirit's manna from on high, they ask <u>Him</u>, who tells them what to learn, where to go, and what to do.

Why doesn't the Western Church follow this pattern?

We believe Holy Spirit is waiting for us to build a relationship with Him that takes precedence over every other relationship, wish, and teaching. In the majestic Name above all Names!

We are encouraged to see many pastors from all over the world going down to Tampa to learn from *The Great Awakening*. They learn to decrease their own presence and control to welcome Holy Spirit to come and lead the way so the power of God will be manifest to our lost and dying world.

It is He, Holy Spirit, who will teach us what we need to know at any moment. He will lead us in these last days just as He led Jesus Himself, who showed us in the Gospels how to activate His heavenly Kingdom. We need to do the same.

He is waiting for us to ask to receive the supernatural power for the ministry to which Abba has called us to. He created us to do good works. (Ephesians 2:10)

We believe Abba is waiting for churches to transform themselves into those who cry out to Him directly for the deeper matters of Abba Father in these last days, weeping at our own altars for the Fire and Light, Power and Might of God.

Before it's too late to bring in the harvest. (Matthew 24:36-44)

Holy Spirit loves to be talked to. He is grieved when we don't inquire of Him.

Do we need churches? Of course! We need places for new believers to learn, to serve, and to be raised up to be soul winners.

Do we need pastors and teachers? Of course! They have the responsibility of leading their congregation into strength, wisdom, and soul winning.

### Prayer and Our Holy Spirit

We have been in local churches where only the leaders pray, while the rest are, in essence, an audience.

While we certainly understand how satan is a master at keeping us from praying, we want to encourage the local churches to ask Holy Spirit how we can pray together, with the leader making it a priority to draw out the heart cries of each of the members who have made it a priority in their own lives to be there *at* that prayer time. (Proverbs 20:5)

We have found that being still and asking for what He, the Spirit, wants us to do today has exploded my husband's and my relationship with the Godhead. We sing songs to each member. We find that out of these precious times comes clarity for direction and prayers.

### Women, the Church, and Holy Spirit

We have truthfully been in churches where some women reminded us of abused children or spouses or even like some parents of teenagers.

They seemed careful. Very, very careful.

To not step out of bounds. To be sure to quench the Holy Spirit gifts in them.

But He tells us in Philippians 4:6 to: "Be careful for nothing, but in prayer and supplication, Let your requests be made known to God."

Galatians 3:28 reminds us in the Spirit there is neither male nor female. In heaven, we are told there "will be no marrying or giving in marriage." (Matthew 22:23-30) Rather, we will be like angels in heaven, Jesus told the Sadducees.

Since we will all be together eternally, will it not be embarrassing and grieving when those who have not raised up their women watch Jesus raising them up to their potential in front of our eyes?

How many pastors and husbands have made it a priority to reach out to the woman in the flock or the wife in his home and draw her out, as Proverbs 20:5 exhorts? How many pastors and husbands think FIRST of the women in their lives, and the giftings He has put in her?

In marriages, does the husband follow the guidance of Paul, esteeming his wife better than himself? (Philippians 2:3)

There is a wealth of gifting not tapped into in many of our churches, we sense, and churches are handicapped because of this. We believe Holy Spirit is quenched when everyone is not raised up to the fullness of their calling, and this, we believe, is one of the reasons our churches don't flow in the power of God.

We remember the wife of a leader with severe depression. We could see wonderful giftings in her and sensed then that there was not much place for her to use them. Now that she and her husband lead a congregation, we hope and pray she no longer fights the demon of depression. Our experience with depression before we were saved suggests that at least one of the reasons for depression might be due to one's spirit not being able to be expressed.

Why aren't there Kathryn Kulhmans and Aimee McPhersons among us now?

### Summary
