



# Introduction

---

The bible teaches that in the beginning a transcendent God created the universe including the heavens and the earth and everything in them. He created light and all matter including the design of matter with subatomic particles, forces including gravity, the physics and chemistry parameters and the level of each fixed constant.

In heaven He created angelic beings, principalities and powers. On earth He created all plant life and animal life. He created mankind in the image of God and mankind (Adam and Eve) lived in the presence of God and talked to Him.

After the creation of heaven and earth, "God saw everything that He had made," and said "indeed it was very good." Consequently, at the beginning, the harmony both in heaven and on earth was perfect. However, the bible teaches that at some point Lucifer, the anointed cherub and some of the other angels, rebelled against their creator and His legitimate authority because he or they wanted to be like God. At some time later Lucifer was not content that it was only himself and some of the angels in rebellion against God the Creator.

The bible tells the story of how Lucifer seduced Eve, and subsequently Adam through Eve, to join him in rebellion against the Creator God, the legitimate authority. Until the time that Lucifer rebelled there was no imperfection or disharmony in heaven. That was the origin of evil in heaven. Until Lucifer seduced Eve to also rebel against God by disobeying Him everything was perfect on earth with no disharmony, death or suffering. That was the origin of evil and sin in heaven and on the earth.

The bible tells the story that Lucifer (Satan) and his fallen angels have no path to redemption and are doomed ultimately to eternal punishment. However, this is not so for us (mankind) even though we were also created in the image of fallen man. Genesis 5:1-3 states:

This is the book of the genealogy of Adam. In the day that God created man, He made him in the likeness of God. 2 He created them male and female, and blessed them and called them Mankind in the day they were created. 3 And Adam lived one hundred and thirty years, and begot a son in **his own likeness, after his image**, and named him Seth.

God has provided a path to redemption through His Son Jesus Christ for us. However, that path requires us to cease rebelling against Him. In the same way, evil will not end and we will not have peace on the earth until those who insist on rebellion against God are taken out of the way.

To understand the anatomy of evil we need to understand that all evil is based upon rebellion against God and His principles. The bible also teaches that

we are the focal point of a battle between God and Satan. The battle centers around a debate of whether Satan was justified in rebelling against God and then trying to justify his rebellion. One way for him to accomplish that would be for him to influence mankind to rebel against God. Certainly, that was the case with Job. And certainly most if not all of the evil in our world revolves around Satan and the powers of darkness trying to physically and spiritually destroy mankind and the plan of God. The bible documents historically how Satan has consistently tried to destroy God's plan in many ways. Today, evil in our world is growing rapidly just like it did in the days of Noah before the flood.

Dr. David Reagan documented a plethora of various evils that are skyrocketing in America and in our world today on a Christ in Prophecy television program.<sup>1</sup> He points out the skyrocketing of evil in America and identifies the cause of those evils as our nation turns against God and Christianity; basically the fact that we have become a secular and Pagan nation. His comments are paraphrased below:

- Since 1973 we have murdered 4000 unborn babies per day for a total of about 60 million
- We are consuming about half the illegal drugs and are only 5% of the world population
- We are spending about 2.8 billion dollars on pornography per year out of 4.9 billion spent worldwide
- Cohabitation has increased 10 fold since 1960 with 12,000,000 cohabiting today
- Our divorce rate is the highest in the world
- 40% of children are born to unmarried women
- We spend 100 billion per year on gambling
- We have about 17.6 million adult alcoholics or have alcohol problems
- Our nation has become a debt junkie and are addicted to both government and personal debt
- We continually blaspheme God's name or His Son's name on TV and in movies
- We have forsaken Israel and demand her to surrender her heartland and divide Jerusalem, her capital city
- We are calling evil good and good evil and we are paying the price
- Our schools have become arenas of deadly violence
- Our prisoner population has increased exponentially, going from 500,000 in 1980 to 2,500,000 today
- We have 7,200,000 who are under correctional supervision

- We have 1,500,000 women reported victims of domestic violence with most not being reported
  - We are currently averaging over 3,000,000 child abuse cases each year involving 6,000,000 children
  - We have experienced more than 12,000,000 crimes per year more than any other nation
  - Teen violence has increased exponentially, with youngsters being killed over tennis shoes
  - Gangs are terrorizing our cities and even the nicest of our neighborhoods are not even safe requiring us to protect our homes with security systems and weapons
  - Our money is becoming become increasing worthless
  - Our economy is being choked to death by a pile of debt that is beyond comprehension
  - Our major corporations and labor unions are in bondage to greed
  - Our society has become deeply divided, splintered among competing groups defined by racial, religious and economic factors
  - Our families are being destroyed by an epidemic of divorce
  - Our entertainment industry consists of barbarians amusing barbarians
  - One of our fastest growing businesses is the Pagan practice of tattooing and body piercing
  - Our universities and media outlets are controlled by radical leftists who hold God in contempt
  - Our federal government has become top heavy with bureaucrats that have become insensitive to taxpayers
  - Our politicians have become more concerned with power than service
  - All levels of government have become increasingly oppressive seeking to regulate every aspect of our lives
  - Taxation has become confiscatory in nature
  - Our legal system has been hijacked by activists who desire to impose their will on the people regardless of what the people desire
  - Our freedom of speech has been threatened by hate crime legislation
  - Our forums of sports are becoming increasing violent, reminiscent of the gladiators of ancient Rome
  - Our society has become “star struck” more interested in celebrities than people of integrity
  - Our churches have been caught up in an epidemic of apostasy as they set aside the word of God in an effort to cozy up to the world and gain its approval

- We are experiencing one major natural disaster after another in unprecedented volume and ferocity
- We have become afflicted with a plague of sexual perversion producing an army of hard core militant homosexuals

All of these skyrocketing evils in America have been occurring at the same time that God and Christianity have become increasingly less popular and where our culture is increasingly hostile toward God and Christianity. Dr. Reagan recounts the story of Jim Garlow, a Nazarene minister, who pastors the Skyline Church in La Mesa California in the same program. Pastor Garlow presented the following table to the National Religious Broadcasters. He is considered to be an expert on Church history. The Quoted table documented below shows the change in which the culture has viewed God and Christianity:

1607-1833	The Establishment (236 years)
1833-1918	The predominant Force (85 years)
1918-1968	The sub-dominant Force (50 years)
1968-1988	A sub-culture (20 years)
1988- 1998	A Counter Culture (10 years)
1998-2008	An Antithetical Culture (10 years)
2008- Present	A persecuted Culture (7+ years) <sup>2</sup>

This illustrates that when we rebel against God and suppress biblical truth, evil thrives and the promoters of truth become the persecuted class.

Satan has many deceptions that he uses to keep us in rebellion against God. One way Satan attempts to destroy us is by making self-destructive behaviors attractive when the actual effect is to destroy us. Some of these allurements include promiscuous and perverted sexual behaviors and mind altering drugs. These allurements are particularly effective since they are addictive and ensnare us, consequently they prevent us from coming to God to repent and getting our life changed. Satan has so many other ways of keeping us from accepting the legitimate God and keeping us in rebellion against Him. Some of these involve pleasure, distractions and various idols.

In this book we seek to examine the anatomy of evil from different perspectives. In Part 1 we look more at the source of evil, realize the prevalence of evil, examine the attributes of Satan and learn some additional concepts of evil. In Part 2 we identify the ways of recognizing evil. In Part 3 we learn how diametrically opposite beliefs can essentially prove the existence of God and the truth of the bible. In Part 4 we will learn of the false foundations that have been built and accepted to support false cultural and political positions and philosophies. In Part 5 we will learn about the church's complete failure to teach the whole council of God to expose the false cultural and political beliefs and to produce bible based Christians. In Part 6 we will learn why evil has progressed so rapidly from additional causes beyond the failure in our churches. In Part 7 we will ask

where America is politically, coming into the 2016 elections. In Part 8 we will ask what we can do to resist and defeat evil from within.

The only answer is for America to recognize its rebellion against God and to repent and change its ways. Without that dramatic change, America is in a tenuous position and awaiting the judgement of a holy and righteous God. Also in Part 8 we document information that will give those who do not have confidence in the truth of the bible reasons to give them confidence. I sincerely hope from reading this book that you will develop a new insight into evil, how you can avoid it and most importantly what you can do to expose evil and promote God and biblical truth.

## **Getting the true picture of evil**

## CHAPTER 1

# What is the source of evil?

---

Saul Alinsky, through his book, “Rules for Radicals,” through his philosophy, and with his life, set the stage perfectly to support the thrust of this book. Saul Alinsky believed that Lucifer’s rebellion against God was a good thing. He stated the following in the introduction to his book, “Rules for Radicals”:

Lest we forget at least an over-the-shoulder acknowledgment to the very first radical: from all our legends, mythology, and history (and who is to know where mythology leaves off and history begins—or which is which), the first radical known to man who rebelled against the establishment and did it so effectively that he at least won his own kingdom—Lucifer.<sup>3</sup>

Surprisingly, the bible agrees with Alinsky except for a few caveats. The main caveat being that Lucifer’s rebellion was not a good thing for Lucifer, Alinsky or the rest of us in the world even though Alinsky sees it that way! Also the bible clarifies that it is history, not legend. However, the bible does agree that Lucifer’s actions as a result of his rebellion did win him his own kingdom at least for a period of time. The fact that Alinsky is aligned with the satanic rebellion is also verified by a 1972 interview with “Playboy.” In it he said, “If there is an afterlife, and I have anything to say about it, I will unreservedly choose to go to hell.” When the interviewer asked why, Alinsky said, “Hell would be heaven for me. Once I get into hell, I’ll start organizing the have-nots over there. They’re my kind of people.”<sup>4</sup> We will discuss the biblical support for the existence of Satan and the ongoing battle between God and Satan further throughout this book.

The word rebellion and the concept of a rebel is both interesting and revealing. Rebellion means to resist and disobey authority whether against God, parents or government. It usually has the connotation of rebelling against a legitimate authority. Certainly Lucifer rebelled against a legitimate authority. God being the creator of all things including Lucifer, principalities and powers, certainly was a legitimate authority. That makes rebellion unjust since it is against a legitimate authority. Consequently, rebellion against an illegitimate authority is not rebellion but a just cause. Police action against a crime syndicate is an example of a just cause, not rebellion. When Alinsky sees what Lucifer did as a good thing, he admits that he is a fellow rebel and a partner in crime. This can be shown not only from this biblical analogy, but from showing that his cause is illegitimate, based upon both biblical principles and real world evidence. When others accept Alinsky’s rebellion, philosophy and beliefs they are

just continuing the chain of rebellion and false beliefs that started with Lucifer and are supporting the evil in our world today.

By definition, those rebelling against an authority, adopt exactly the diametrically opposite worldview beliefs that the legitimate authority holds up as truth. If they agreed with the authority on important worldview beliefs, they would not be resisting and rebelling against the authority. Consequently, Alinsky and all of us that are in rebellion against authority have diametrically opposite worldview beliefs than the authority, which, being legitimate, is the true belief that has desirable long term effects. Consequently, Alinsky and all of us agree that important diametrically opposite worldview beliefs have a profound significance. When we see them we can be assured that if one side is right, true and just the other side is wrong, false and unjust. It is just that Alinsky believes that rebellion against the legitimate authority is just. Later in the book we will show that his rebellion is not just (as in justified) based upon evidence and rationale.

Unfortunately, those groups and individuals pushing wrong, false and unjust philosophies and positions on issues are legion. They include academia, media, entertainment, politics, economics, and religions. The modus operandi for selling these wrong, false and unjust beliefs are the same ones that Lucifer used in the Garden of Eden and what the bible documents as Satan's modus operandi. The primary ways that the evil forces have been able to convince us to accept essentially a completely false worldview that is diametrically opposite from a biblical worldview is by establishing a false foundation to build upon and by seducing us to into fleshly, sinful behaviors that create a conflict of interest within us that makes us susceptible to rationalizing away and suppressing the truth.

We will also show that the diametric opposition of worldviews we see in our world is no accident, but results from a guiding force ensuring opposition on every issue. After establishing that concept we will expose the manifestation of these evils on multiple fronts. However, before we go there, we need to better understand the biblical story and biblical concepts in this chapter.

## **CREATION STORY**

Most people know the story well. After God created Adam and Eve in the image of God and placed them in a perfect creation with only one thing that they (or at least Adam) were instructed not to do. Genesis 2:16-17 states:

<sup>16</sup> And the LORD God commanded the man, saying, "Of every tree of the garden you may freely eat; <sup>17</sup> but of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil you shall not eat, for in the day that you eat of it you shall surely die."

The story continues in Chapter 3 verses 1-6 where the serpent, indwelt by Lucifer, tempted Eve through questioning God's motives and credibility and got her to eat the forbidden fruit.

Now the serpent was more cunning than any beast of the field which the LORD God had made. And he said to the woman, "Has God indeed said, 'You shall not eat of every tree of the garden?'"<sup>2</sup> And the woman said to the serpent, "We may eat the fruit of the trees of the garden;<sup>3</sup> but of the fruit of the tree which is in the midst of the garden, God has said, 'You shall not eat it, nor shall you touch it, lest you die.'"<sup>4</sup> Then the serpent said to the woman, "You will not surely die.<sup>5</sup> For God knows that in the day you eat of it your eyes will be opened, and you will be like God, knowing good and evil."<sup>6</sup> So when the woman saw that the tree was good for food, that it was pleasant to the eyes, and a tree desirable to make one wise, she took of its fruit and ate. She also gave to her husband with her, and he ate.

The story continues with God cursing the serpent in Genesis 3:14:

So the LORD God said to the serpent:

"Because you have done this, You are cursed more than all cattle,  
And more than every beast of the field; On your belly you shall go,  
And you shall eat dust All the days of your life.

The story continues with the first prophecy in the bible in Genesis 3:15:

And I will put enmity  
Between you and the woman,  
And between your seed and her Seed;  
He shall bruise your head,  
And you shall bruise His heel."

This prophecy is in reference to Jesus, being born of woman, and that He will bruise (some versions say crush) Lucifer's or Satan's head but in the process Satan will bruise Jesus' heel. This is in reference to Jesus, the creator of the universe, leaving His heavenly domain, being born of the Virgin Mary, living a sinless life and being Crucified on a Roman cross to become sin so we can take on his rightness and be saved from what we deserve. John 19:30 states Jesus' last words were "it is finished:"

<sup>30</sup> So when Jesus had received the sour wine, He said, "It is finished!"  
And bowing His head, He gave up His spirit.

What did Jesus mean by "it is finished?" One website stated:

Of the last sayings of Christ on the cross, none is more important or more poignant than, "It is finished." Found only in the Gospel of John, the Greek word translated "it is finished" is *tetelestai*, an accounting term that means "paid in full." When Jesus uttered those words, He was declaring the debt owed to His Father was wiped away completely and forever.

Also completed was the fulfillment of all Old Testament prophecies, symbols, and foreshadowings of the coming Messiah. From Genesis to Malachi, there are over 300 specific prophecies detailing the coming of the Anointed One, all fulfilled by Jesus. From the “seed” who would crush the serpent’s head (Genesis 3:15), to the Suffering Servant of Isaiah 53, . . .<sup>5</sup>

Another website stated that:

He was declaring victory over the enemy—Satan, sin and death.<sup>6</sup>

Although Satan no longer had a claim on legal grounds to condemn us to death for our sins, he still has that power if we let him by not accepting Jesus’ atonement for our sins. The cure is fully paid for, but we must lay a claim to it. His power to even tempt mankind will be suspended for a 1000 years during the millennial reign (Revelation 20:1-3), but his physical defeat will not be completed until after the millennium (Revelation 20:10).

The story continues in Chapter 3:16 where God curses the woman.

To the woman He said: “I will greatly multiply your sorrow and your conception;  
In pain you shall bring forth children;  
Your desire shall be for your husband,  
And he shall rule over you.”

The story continues with God cursing the man in Genesis 3:17-19.

<sup>17</sup> Then to Adam He said, “Because you have heeded the voice of your wife, and have eaten from the tree of which I commanded you, saying, ‘You shall not eat of it’: “Cursed is the ground for your sake; In toil you shall eat of it All the days of your life. <sup>18</sup> Both thorns and thistles it shall bring forth for you, And you shall eat the herb of the field. <sup>19</sup> In the sweat of your face you shall eat bread Till you return to the ground, For out of it you were taken; For dust you are, And to dust you shall return.”

The final result was that death entered our world and the serpent, Satan, woman, man and the earth were cursed. The rest of the universe may have been cursed as well. From then on man was not made only in the image of God, but in the fallen image of man also. Genesis 5:1-3 states:

This is the book of the genealogy of Adam. In the day that God created man, He made him in the likeness of God. <sup>2</sup> He created them male and female, and blessed them and called them Mankind in the day they were created. <sup>3</sup> And Adam lived one hundred and thirty years, and begot a son in his own likeness, after his image, and named him Seth.

It is interesting to notice that God did not curse the institution of marriage and make what He had already created obsolete. Genesis 2:18, 22-24 states:

<sup>18</sup> And the LORD God said, “It is not good that man should be alone; I will make him a helper comparable to him.”

<sup>22</sup> Then the rib which the LORD God had taken from man He made into a woman, and He brought her to the man. <sup>23</sup> And Adam said: "This is now bone of my bones And flesh of my flesh; She shall be called Woman, Because she was taken out of Man." <sup>24</sup> Therefore a man shall leave his father and mother and be joined to his wife, and they shall become one flesh.

Previously God stated in Genesis 1:27-28:

<sup>27</sup> So God created man in His own image; in the image of God He created him; male and female He created them. <sup>28</sup> Then God blessed them, and God said to them, "Be fruitful and multiply; fill the earth and subdue it; have dominion over the fish of the sea, over the birds of the air, and over every living thing that moves on the earth."

Although God gave man dominion over the remainder of his creation, He also expected us to care for the creation. Genesis 2:15 states:

<sup>15</sup> Then the LORD God took the man and put him in the Garden of Eden to tend and keep it.

Although most of readers know about Lucifer and the Garden of Eden, familiarity with the whole story is not as common. The remainder of the story about Satan will be completed in Chapter 3. In the next chapter we will discuss the prevalence of evil. The remainder of Part 1 will identify concepts relating to evil.
