

### STEWARDSHIP: SUMMER 2013



It's hard to believe that summer is here already. Spring came and went so quickly, but what a wonder-

ful series of events we had over the last few months. Starting with a beautiful Lenten period, we then entered the joy of Pascha and the opening of our new Church, which was attended by hundreds of existing and perhaps many new stewards. Already there has been interest shown in joining St. Demetrios by several families. We hope this will continue as we worship together in our new home.

The first quarter of the year showed an increase in pledge dollars by our stewards while the overall number of stewards is relatively steady. Through May 15th, we had 336 pledges totaling \$325,258 and an additional \$18,501 from 91 non pledged members. We've received \$187,153 in cash so far which is about \$8k higher than last year at this time. Our average pledge continues to increase as it now approaches almost \$1,000.

Statements will be going out after Memorial Day. As always, we ask that you please carefully review to make sure we have captured your pleage and donations accurately. If you are using the online donation system, you can easily log in and review your electronic contributions in one place and instantly get a snapshot of your pleage status.


