Quilt display requirements

1. Each quilt must have a three (3) inch sleeve, minimum for hanging. Cut a strip of fabric 6 ½” wide x length of the top of your quilt. Fold in half and stitch a ¼” seam. Pin in place on quilt back. Whip stitch along both top and bottom edges of sleeve.
2. Sew or pin NAME, ADDRESS, And PHONE NUMBER on back of quilt.
3. Place quilt in its own CLEAR plastic bag, secure with a twist tie and securely tape label (provided below) on bag.

Delivery and pick-up of Entries

1. Entries are to be delivered to Middlebury Recreation Building on Creek Road, Middlebury, VT on **Friday, October 6, 2017 from 4:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m.** For other arrangements, contact Nancy Skidmore (802-453-5276) or e-mail her at njskid0220@gmavt.net
2. Entries may be picked up at Middlebury Recreation Building on **Sunday, October 8 from 3:30 p.m. to 4:30 p.m.** If you are unable to pick up your own entry, please provide a written note authorizing the person with the note to pick up your entry and give them the matching half of the entry ticket that you’ll receive when the item is dropped off. **Whoever picks up the entry item MUST HAVE THE MATCHING HALF OF THE ENTRY TICKET - no ticket, no item.**
