**NOTICE OF RESET HEARING (TO JULY 31, 2013) ON
REHABILITATOR'S MOTION FOR AN ORDER CONFIRMING
AUTHORITY TO TERMINATE RESIDENTIAL MORTGAGE
LOAN SERVICER AND APPOINT SUCCESSOR SERVICER**

**By the Commissioner of Insurance of the State of Wisconsin,
as Rehabilitator of the Segregated Account of Ambac Assurance Corporation**

TO: All Parties-in-Interest

As previously noticed, the Commissioner of Insurance of the State of Wisconsin, as Rehabilitator of the Segregated Account of Ambac Assurance Corporation, moved the Court on April 5, 2013 for an order: 1) confirming the contractual authority of Ambac Assurance Corporation ("Ambac") to direct the termination of OneWest Bank, F.S.B. ("OneWest") as the servicer for residential mortgage loans held by the IndyMac Certificate Trust 2004-2 and the IndyMac Residential Asset-Backed Trust, Series 2004-LH1 (together, the "Trusts"), and to direct the appointment of Green Tree Servicing LLC ("Green Tree") as the successor servicer; 2) directing Deutsche Bank National Trust Company ("Deutsche Bank"), in its capacity as trustee ("Trustee"), to follow Ambac's direction to terminate OneWest as servicer and appoint Green Tree as the successor servicer of the Trusts and to take all actions necessary to effect the termination of OneWest and the appointment of Green Tree; and 3) enjoining OneWest and any other party from taking actions to prevent such termination and appointment (the "Servicing Motion").

The Servicing Motion originally was scheduled to be heard on May 1, 2013; that hearing was reset to May 24, 2013 at the request of OneWest. Prior to the May 24, 2013 hearing date, OneWest removed the Servicing Motion to the United States District Court for the Western District of Wisconsin. On July 8, 2013, that court granted the Rehabilitator's motion to remand, and therefore this Court again has jurisdiction over the Servicing Motion.


PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the Servicing Motion has now been rescheduled by the Court to be heard on July 31, 2013, commencing at 1:30 p.m. (Central Time) before the Honorable William D. Johnston at the Lafayette County Courthouse, 626 Main Street, Darlington, Wisconsin. Any objections to the relief requested by the Rehabilitator in this Motion should be in writing, and must now be filed and served by no later than noon (Central Time) on July 25, 2013.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that any parties in interest may appear at the hearing in person or telephonically pursuant to the Court's standard tele-court procedure.
