MOTION FOR ADMISSION PRO HAC VICE OF JOHN C. ("KIT") WEITNAUER

In accordance with Wisconsin Supreme Court Rule ("SCR") 10.03(4)(b), Wells Fargo Bank, Trustee for RMBS Certificate Holders ("Wells Fargo"), by Jane C. Schlicht of Hinshaw & Culbertson LLP, hereby moves the Court to admit *pro hac vice* John C. ("Kit") Weitnauer of Alston & Bird LLP, One Atlantic Center, 1201 W. Peachtree Street, Atlanta, GA 30309-3424 in the above-captioned proceeding. In support of this motion, Wells Fargo submits the Application of John C. ("Kit") Weitnauer along with the Affidavit of Jane C. Schlicht in Support of Defendant's Motion for *Pro Hac Vice* Admission ("Schlicht Affidavit"), and states as follows:

1. John C. ("Kit") Weitnauer is nonresident counsel.
2. Pursuant to SCR 10.03(4)(b), this Court may allow nonresident counsel to appear and participate in a particular action or proceeding in association with an active member of the State Bar of Wisconsin, who also appears in the action or proceeding.
3. Mr. Weitnauer is admitted to practice law before the Georgia State Courts, the Supreme Court of the United States, the 11th Circuit, and the Northern District of Georgia. *See* John C. ("Kit") Weitnauer's Application for *Pro Hac Vice* Admission filed contemporaneously with this motion and attached as Exhibit A to the Schlicht Affidavit.

4. Mr. Weitnauer is in good standing in his courts of admission and has never been disbarred, censured, or sanctioned by the bar of any court. See Exhibit A to the Schlicht Affidavit.




