**MOTION FOR ADMISSION *PRO HAC VICE*  
OF BRIAN PFEIFFER AND JOHN J. RAMIREZ**

In accordance with Wisconsin Supreme Court Rule (“SCR”) 10.03(4)(b), the Ad Hoc Group, by Godfrey & Kahn, S.C., hereby moves the Court to admit *pro hac vice* Brian Pfeiffer and John J. Ramirez of White & Case LLP, 1221 Avenue of the Americas, New York, New York 10020-1095, in the above-captioned proceeding. In support of this motion, the Ad Hoc Group submits the Applications of Brian Pfeiffer and John J. Ramirez, along with the Affidavit of James A. Friedman in Support of Petitioner’s Motion for *Pro Hac Vice* Admission (“Friedman Affidavit”), and states as follows:

1. Brian Pfeiffer is nonresident counsel.
2. John J. Ramirez is nonresident counsel.

6. Mr. Ramirez is admitted to practice law before the courts of New York. *See John J. Ramirez's Application for Pro Hac Vice Admission filed contemporaneously with this motion and attached as Exhibit B to the Friedman Affidavit.*

7. Mr. Ramirez is in good standing in his courts of admission and has never been disbarred, censured, or sanctioned by the bar of any court. *See Exhibit B to the Friedman Affidavit.*

8. On December 20, 2017, Applications for *Pro Hac Vice* Admission of Mr. Pfeiffer and Mr. Ramirez were submitted to the Wisconsin Office of Lawyer Regulation along with payment of the \$500.00 application fees. *See Exhibit C to the Friedman Affidavit.*

A proposed Order granting this motion is attached.

WHEREFORE, the Ad Hoc Group respectfully requests that the Court enter an order allowing the admission *pro hac vice* of nonresident Attorneys Brian Pfeiffer and John J. Ramirez.
