MHPI Projects v. Sean Dilweg (L.C. # 2010CV1576)

Before Fitzpatrick, J.

The petitioners, collectively known as the Military Housing Privatization Initiative (MHPI) Projects, move for relief pending appeal and temporary relief pending the disposition of their motion. They seek to enjoin the circuit court from enforcing an injunction it issued on February 7, 2018, which is one of the subjects of this appeal.

Given the stakes involved in this litigation, I am not persuaded that ex parte relief is appropriate. Rather than granting temporary relief, I will shorten the deadline for the insurance commissioner and Ambac to respond to the motion for relief pending appeal.

Therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that the motion for temporary relief is denied.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the deadline for the insurance commissioner and Ambac to respond to the motion for relief pending appeal shall be Monday March 12, 2018, at 1:30 p.m.
