of Ambac Assurance Corporation**


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The Office of the Wisconsin Commissioner of Insurance, as Court-appointed Rehabilitator of the Segregated Account of Ambac Assurance Corporation, hereby moves the Court for leave to file a brief slightly in excess of the 40-page limit imposed by Local Rule 502. The Rehabilitator's Consolidated Brief in Opposition to All Motions Scheduled for Hearing on September 9, 2010 includes the Rehabilitator's responses to arguments raised by eleven movants

across seven briefs. Rather than filing seven separate briefs in response to those arguments, each of which would be subject to a separate 40-page limit, the Rehabilitator believed it more efficient to file a single brief addressing all non policy-specific legal challenges to his actions. The Rehabilitator respectfully requests that the Court grant leave to file those pages of the Consolidated Brief that exceed the 40-page limit of Local Rule 502. If the Court is disinclined to grant leave to exceed that page limit, the Rehabilitator alternatively requests that the Court consider those arguments beginning at Part III of the Consolidated Brief as a separate brief, which would be consistent with Ambac Assurance Corporation's division of responsive briefs on these motions.
