Recently seen on *BBC News*, *Sky News*, *ITV News*, *Fox News*, *Conan* and *ITV's Bad Move*, join **Seann Walsh** as he recounts the week following 6th October 2018 during which he was famously under-marked for his Paso Doble. **After This One I'm Going Home** is an edifying story of what it is like to be slap bang in the centre of a media storm and the turbulent time he experienced while appearing on the biggest show on television, *Strictly Come Dancing*.

Following on from his smash-hit spring UK tour, Edinburgh Comedy Award nominee, 2018 *Strictly Come Dancing* contestant and self-proclaimed 'Lie-in King' Seann returns to the Edinburgh Festival Fringe this August with his new stand-up show **After This One I'm Going Home**.

Seann will be performing nightly throughout the Edinburgh Festival Fringe from **Wednesday 31st July to Sunday 25th August (not Wednesday 12th August) at 8.30pm at The Pleasance Dome (King Dome)**. Tickets are on sale now and available from www.edfringe.com and www.pleasance.co.uk.

"Unquestionably the best observational comic of his generation" (*The Guardian*), this dishevelled, fiery, animated, fiercely idle, millennial man-child is currently one of the UK's finest live comedians. Currently on tour around the UK with *After This One I'm Going Home*, Seann has been met with sell-out audiences across the country and has received rapturous critical acclaim from critics.

With recent appearances on BBC One's *Strictly Come Dancing* and ITV2's *The Stand Up Sketch Show* and as a team captain on *Virtually Famous* (Channel 4) Seann is no stranger to the small screen. Other TV appearances include *Play To The Whistle One For The Road* (BBC 3), *Live At The Apollo* (BBC 2), *The Jonathan Ross Show* (ITV), *Tonight at The London Palladium* (ITV), *Celebrity Juice* (ITV2), *8 Out Of 10 Cats* (Channel 4), *8 Out Of 10 Cats Does Countdown* (Channel 4), *Alan Carr's Chatty Man* (Channel 4) and *Russell Howard's Stand Up Central* (Comedy Central). Seann made his US TV debut in 2018 with an appearance on popular talk show *Conan*.

Since appearing on *Strictly Come Dancing*, Seann has gone on to host Netflix's newest comedy game-show *Flinch*, alongside Desiree Burch and Lloyd Griffith. The full series is available to stream online now following its release on 3rd May 2019.

Not only a talented comedian, Seann has quickly become a well-respected actor, most recently co-starring in ITV1 sitcom *Bad Move* alongside Jack Dee. The hugely successful first series was broadcast in autumn 2017 and returned to ITV1 in autumn 2018 for a six episode series and a Christmas special, which was broadcast on Christmas Eve on ITV1.

Other acting credits include starring in Comedy Central's sitcom *Big Bad World*, Sky's silent comedy *Three Kinds of Stupid* and he made his feature film debut in 2018's family comedy *2:hrs*, released in August 2018. He has also turned his hand to writing with his own Sky Arts Comedy Shorts Series in 2016 and he wrote and produced his very own comedy web-series *The Drunk*.

Seann also hosts his weekly radio show and podcast *News-Ish* on Fubar Radio, alongside co-host Mark Simmons.

Seann is currently touring *After The One I'm Going Home* around the UK with dates continuing until June. For dates see www.seannwalsh.com.
