ABOUT

Award-winning *Mimi's Suitcase* is a universal story of displacement, resilience and humanity. Raw, authentic, relevant and vibrant, the story centers on questions of identity in Iran, Spain and England with nothing but the titular suitcase, a raincoat and a scarf. A tour-de-force performed in three languages with English surtitles.

Following a sold-out world premiere in New York City in 2015, Mimi's Suitcase won the **Audience Choice Award for Best Play** at Kulturverein Boje Theatre Festival in Heidelberg in 2016 and has been performing worldwide including a sell-out run at the Edinburgh Iranian Festival in 2016 and a successful three-week run at Edinburgh Festival Fringe where it was longlisted for an **Amnesty Freedom of Expression** award in 2017.

About Ana:

Ana is a multilingual and multicultural theatre, film, voice-over actress and linguist based in San Francisco, California. She holds a B.A. Honours in Linguistics, an M.A. in Film and a Post-Graduate Diploma in Acting from Birmingham School of Acting. Ana will next be seen in the soon-to-be-released feature film *Waiting for Kiarostami* (Stella Studios).

Artist Statement:

As a snapshot of the experiences I had returning to my native Iran after a happy and carefree upbringing in Spain, *Mimi's Suitcase* embodies the personal gravitas of experiencing a completely different Iran from the one I remembered in the early 1970s. "Charlie's Angels" had given way to war slogans and a strict social moral code for which many of us were unprepared. Young people were seeking refuge in popular culture. Underground video clips, posters and cassettes sold in the black market gave us momentary respite from the suffocation we endured as we masked our true feelings in the public eye. What kept us going was an inherent resilience based on shared humanity and the deep knowledge that we were not alone, even though we felt we were born in the wrong side of the world.

In writing this personal yet historically-influenced story, one of my goals was to pay homage to belief and hope for a world in which we can no longer make blanket statements about people's origins without knowing their complete stories. To this end, my narrative spans 27 characters who speak in their own way using Castilian Spanish, Persian, British English and standard American English.

It is my heartfelt mission to use the art of storytelling to bring us all together in the realization that we have more in common than what sets us apart.
