Status:

- Culverts: Database is updated; meeting with R. Kiene of ACRPC 7/30/09 for GPS designations for new culverts will be submitted to the Selectboard at the August 10th meeting
- Bridges: VCGI database requires full update; compare with existing internal spreadsheet and confirm that all data is included in the VCGI database; efficiency dictates to have only one data collection cite updates will be complete by meeting of August 24th.
- Roads: in process of being created. A sample at the August 24th meeting.+

Mr. Karpak is requesting input from the Board re: data and format for reporting. The Board requests a format proposal for the reports for their review. The Board Chair requested a timeline for the completion of the databases. Further discussion at the meeting of August 10, 2009.

Hi Ren:

The Board requested the following:

- (1) Please proceed with a draft of the letter that would address the resident who has not responded to the two letters (copies attached). They would like the letter to be positioned for legal/court action.

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With larger sums at risk in the second flood, the Board wants to make sure their actions are consistent.

(Note to you—would this then be small claims court or what direction? Even if it is small claims court, it should not state that specifically). Also, they wanted your recommendation on what they can do to be assured that the Town would ultimately get repaid).

- (2) A different issue re: property and back taxes. The Board had heard of an instance in another state re: a foreclosed property that was also delinquent in taxes. The Bank tried to sell a foreclosed property and was not able to, the Town then could put that same property up for tax sale. What insight might you have on such a possibility here in Vermont?
