<b>Roads Report</b>				
General	Most roads have been graded and chloride applied. Those to be done are Natural Turnpike, Goshen Rd., and Brooks Rd. Suction hose for the chloride tank was purchased.			
Culverts	Concrete blocks were ordered for culvert headwalls for the Goshen Rd., Lincoln Rd., and Natural Turnpike.			
TAC study grant application	Ripton was awarded a Transportation Advisory Committee (TAC) study grant for armored water crossings on Peddlers Bridge Rd.			
Better Backroads Grants	The application period is open for work to be completed in 2013. Applications will be submitted for projects on Natural Turnpike and the North Branch Rd.			
<b>Old Business</b>				
Cemeteries	Perry Hanson is working on starting a discussion and new commission.			
Post office	The Ripton Country Store owners are submitting an application for the Village Post Office Program.			
Town buildings	Refinishing the Community House floor and completing projects was discussed. Most exterior painting of the town office is done; the stairwell is not. If the interior painting is not finished in 2 weeks, someone new may be hired.			
Dogs	Twenty households that may have unlicensed dogs were sent a letter requesting that they license their dog, or report that they do not have a dog, by July 6 <sup>th</sup> . As of this meeting 2 households responded.			
College	The listers reviewed college properties with Tom Corbin.			
<b>New Business</b>				
Village concern	A letter regarding the appearance of properties on Route 125 at the west end of the village was discussed. The board previously asked the zoning administrator to determine if there are violations of town ordinances. He reported none. Possible activity in the state right-of-way was discussed.
