

SI-Net Email Discussion Group for Administrators

The Supplemental Instruction (SI) email discussion group (SI-Net) is intended as a modern forum for the exchange of ideas among those interested in SI. Several hundred faculty and staff from around the world are participants within this email listserv group. When you email the SI-Net, you are emailing SI supervisors, Certified Trainers, faculty members, and SI leaders around the world!

Purposes of SI-Net include:

- Exchange of ideas and techniques between institutions
- Opportunities for SI leaders to participate in dialogue with SI supervisors and faculty members
- Identification of new educational resources and practices that would be helpful for other members of the network
- Discussion about customizing SI as it is implemented in specific academic content areas and institutions
- Announcements about SI-User group meetings, training opportunities, and job opportunities

SI-Net is an independent, unmoderated, mailing-list interest group. This means it is open to all participants' mailings without editing or prior approval. Though it is made possible by the cooperation and facilities of the participating institutions, its activities or any opinions expressed through it are without the sanction of any unit, department or school. Neither the institutions nor the participating states are responsible for its content. There is no charge from the University of Missouri-Kansas City to subscribe to SI-Net. We look forward to talking with you on the network.

To subscribe to SI-Net, please do the following:

Note: The text in quotes is what you should enter, but you do not need to type the actual quotation marks. Send your email in plain text without signatures and backgrounds. This will prevent many problems.

1. Start a new email addressed to listserv@listserv.umkc.edu
2. Leave the subject line blank.
3. In the body of your message, type, "subscribe sinet yourfirstname yourlastname". For example, if I were entering the message, I would have typed "subscribe sinet Sonny Painter."
4. You will shortly receive a message from the listserv. Simply reply to the message and type "ok" as the body of your message. This procedure will work with any email program.
5. If all has gone well, you should receive a welcome message. If you have problems, contact Sonny Painter at painters@umkc.edu

To UNSUBSCRIBE to SI-Net, please do the following:

1. Start a new email addressed to listserv@listserv.umkc.edu
2. Leave the subject line blank.
3. In the body of your message, type, "signoff sinet." Since the email is sent from you,

the server will remove the email address that sent the message.

After you have subscribed to SI-Net, a few reminders:

1. You can accomplish various tasks by emailing the listserv. Send all correspondence to "listserv@listserv.umkc.edu" (e.g., *help*, *query*, *subscribe*, *signoff*). For example, to sign off the list, send a message to listserv@listserv.umkc.edu with a single line in the body of the message stating "signoff sinet." For help, send an email with the command "help" in the body of the message. If you need any further assistance, email Sonny Painter at painters@umkc.edu
2. To send mail to all SI-Net subscribers, send it to sinet@listserv.umkc.edu If your email is of a more personal nature, please send it directly to the individual by using their address, rather than sending it to everyone on the list. There are more than 350 individuals subscribed to the SI-Net discussion group at this time.
