Steps for Making an E-Book

- 1. Create your book in Word or other versions that can be opened within Apple's Pages word processing package.
 - a. Embed web links, images, and the like.
 - b. Use forced page breaks to separate into chapters.
 - c. Make the first page of the document the "cover page" for the book. Since this will appear as a small icon in the iBooks bookshelf, use just a few words in giant print (e.g., 60 or 72 point) and a large image that fills half the page.
 - d. Post a copy of this document as a PDF online so others can use it that do not have access to an e-reader.
- 2. Open in Apple's Pages word processing software. Follow directions for slight reformatting for images, section headers, etc.
- 3. From the "file" menu, select "Export" and use the "epub" format.
- 4. Save file to the desktop or to another means to get the file to the computer that you sync your iPad.
- 5. Open iTunes on the computer you sync your iPad. Be sure you have already downloaded the free "iBooks" app.
- 6. Drag and drop the ebook file on top of the "books" tab in your iTunes account located on the left side of the screen.
- Sync your iPad to this iTunes account and it will be automatically downloaded.
- 8. Open the iBooks app. Your book should be the first one located on the top shelf.
- 9. Bask in the warmth of being an ebook author.
