PAL Program Podcast Show Professional Development for PAL Facilitators

- **Purpose**: Provide on-going professional development for PAL facilitators from mostly their point-of-view.
- **Format**: Semi-monthly, 30-minute podcast show co-produced by PAL program coordinator, PAL facilitators, PAL supervisor, and course sponsoring PAL faculty member.
- **Coproducers of the Twice-Monthly Podcast** (5 groups of people): course faculty members, course PAL facilitators, PAL program coach, PAL program coordinator

Show Content:

- Show theme music [15 seconds]
- Podcast series introduction [PAL student supervisor; 1 minute; prerecorded and used in all podcasts in the series]
 Short list of announcements and reminders [PAL program coordinator; 1 to 2 minutes]
- Provide one or two facilitator activities or behaviors to consider. Based on PAL facilitator observations by the PAL program coach [PAL coach; 3 to 5 minutes].
 Short introduction to the artist featured in this week's show and the three musical selections [Rotating PAL facilitator; 1 to 2 minutes].
- Musical selection #1
 Study strategies or activities that went well [Rotating PAL facilitator; 3 to 4 minutes]
- Musical selection #2
- Faculty member point-of-view about what they hope occurs as a result of student participation [Rotating course faculty member; 3 minutes]
- Musical selection #3
- Preview of next professional development session and reading selection [PAL program coordinator; 1 to 2 minutes]
- Podcast series theme music and closing credits [PAL program coach; 1 minute; prerecorded and used in all podcasts in the series]
 Prerecorded promo for another highly-rated podcast program produced elsewhere [Rotating promo spots; 1 minute]
- Post podcast show notes and links to additional web-based resources through the PAL blog page (http://palgroups.org).

Additional Program Components in the Future:

- Include telephone interviews with PAL facilitators from other colleges in the Twin Cities area and nationally as podcast program subscriber base grows outside of the UMN campus.
- Respond to questions from PAL facilitators at other colleges about improving study sessions in different academic content areas.
