


Building Experience: Preparation

- Moving the fence and adding a gate
- Adding an electrical circuit
- Tree roots and other obstacles
- Rain: mud, drainage, sump pump, wet timber
- Concrete tiles and pebbles


Building Experience: Tank

- The ground is not level + rain sensitive
- The rebars are bent
- The timber is not straight + rain sensitive
- Use a powerful hammer drill (thanks Gary)
- Use a special long wood drill bit
- Suggest concrete collar + laser level













Building Experience: Plumbing

- Cutting the barrel top
- Sizing the bulkhead holes (thanks Kenneth)
- Leaks in connections
- Aligning the bottom drain pipe to first barrel (a three dimensional puzzle)
- Cleaning the barrels (draining, disconnecting)
- Use flexible pipe








Building Experience: Air Supply

- Hard pipe from air pumps (1/2 inch)
- Air manifold from Aquatic Eco Systems
- Air rings: bottom drain, filter barrels











Building Experience: Water


- Insulation boards

- Brackets to the rescue






















Building Experience: Extras

Operating Experience

- Two koi spawning eggs block filtration
- Adding ClorAm-X and Baking Soda
- Move the koi out and clean everything
- Draining: spigots and pumps
- Wet vac to the rescue
- Need to detach first barrel
- Avoid spawning: young koi (thanks Kathryn) or extra tank
