Through the comedy of the play directed by Sandy Cockrell we attempt to explore the multiple facets and dubious maneuvers by the political machinery in times of elections within the national context. The exhibition creates a contrast, explores the effect of global political changes from the Latin-American perspective.

The artworks presented at the GALLERY 9, tells very personal stories through a seductive invitation to discover the influence and aftermath of global political exchanges. Riots provoked by the repression of public opinions in a peaceful demonstration. The mishandling of economic aids due to corruption exacerbated by the political machine; or the continuation of an archaic blockade in exchange for electoral votes can be some of the results seen of political interventions.

In between the visual conversation can also be found portraits of anger, desperation, a call for immediate change in the political process of one's country, since the affects of local politics are no longer limited to its borders. The artists talk about our necessity to evolve for the better of people, not just for the increment of political influences across the world or the growth of one's economical capital.

At the end, an exhibition that observes issues of intolerance, corruption and the state of the world post 9/11.
