Candlemas-Presentation of the Lord!

Next Saturday, February 2nd, the Church celebrates the Presentation of the Lord in the temple (40 days after Christmas). On this special day the Church traditionally blesses candles for use in the Church throughout the coming year and for home use. This day is commonly called Candlemas Day. Candles will be available for families to use at home. It is appropriate to burn a blessed candle at home during family prayer, for a special intention or for protection during a storm. We are asking for a donation for the candles taken for home use. The bottle candles are \$5.00. A basket will be placed near the candles to collect the candle donations. Candles can also be purchased any time at the Parish Center.
