NOTING THAT:

- (1) The First Respondent commits not to receive and retain the seized documents from the Second Respondent until final determination of proceeding VID 1151/2017 or further order by the Court; and
- (2) The Second Respondent commits to refrain from giving the seized documents to the First Respondent until final determination of proceeding VID1151/2017 or further order by the Court;

BY CONSENT THE COURT ORDERS THAT:

1. On or before 3 November 2017, the parties endeavour to reach agreement on categories of discovery.
2. On or before 10 November 2017 and if such agreement is reached, the parties make discovery of those documents falling within the categories agreed in accordance with paragraph 1 of these Orders.
3. On or before 17 November 2017, the applicant file and serve any additional evidence by way of affidavit on which it intends to rely together with an outline of submissions.
4. On or before 1 December 2017, the respondents file and serve any evidence by way of affidavit on which they intend to rely together with an outline of submissions.



5. The proceeding be listed for hearing in the week commencing 11 December 2017, on an estimate of 2-3 days.
6. The parties have liberty to apply on 48 hours written notice to all other parties.
