

Praying Through Scripture For Your Sponsored Child

How to pray that your child understands God's character:

- That God hears their prayers (1 John 5:14-15)
- That God can deliver them from all of their fears (Psalm 34:4)
- That God will meet their needs (Matthew 7: 7-8)
- That God is greater than any problem (Ephesians 3: 20-21)
- That if their parents are less than perfect, God is the perfect parent (Isaiah 54:13)
- That God can redeem any situation (Psalm 103)
- That even if they face struggles, God is the strength of their heart and the best inheritance (Psalm 73:26)
- That they will have troubles, but God has overcome the world (John 16:33)
- That with God as they're refuge, there is nothing to fear; that they seek God's face (Psalm 27)

How to pray for your child's spiritual growth:

- That they desire to know God (John 17:3)
- That they will know Jesus as the way, truth, and life, and that they have assurance of their place in God's heart (John 14)
- That they will seek God in times of trouble, making Him their refuge (Psalm 46:1)
- That they will be free from sin and guilt and become a new person in Christ (2 Corinthians 5:17)
- That they will find stability and refreshment in God's Word (Psalm 19:7-10)
- That they will abide in God, and God's word in them (John 15:7)
- That they have the wisdom to fear God and base their wisdom on Him (Proverbs 9:10) and not be drawn to the world's wisdom (1 Corinthians 3:19, 1 Timothy 4:7)
- That they will be set free by the truth (John 8:31-32)
- That they will grow in the fruit of the Spirit (Galatians 5:22-23)
- That they will not have a spirit of fear, but of power and love and discipline (2 Timothy 1:7)
- That God will strengthen their soul and fulfill His purpose for them (Psalm 138)

How to pray for the project and staff:

- That they have Jesus' eyes and heart for the little children; that they can bring the children to Jesus (Matthew 19:13-15)
- That they drink deeply of God's Word and prosper in the work God has for them (Psalm 1:1-3)
- That their ministry be an overflow of God's love in their hearts and lives (Matthew 12:34)
- That they not grow weary in their work, that they will see fruit in the lives of the children (Galatians 6:9)
- That they grow in strength, health, and peace (Psalm 23)
- That God will protect the project building, making it a refuge for the children (Psalm 5:11, Psalm 14:6)
- That God put advocates for the children in high and powerful places (Nehemiah 2:18)
- That the staff trust in the Lord even when faced with evil (Psalm 37)

How to pray for your child's country:

- That the country's leadership will humble themselves and pray and seek God's face and turn from their wicked ways; that God will hear them, forgive their sins, and heal their land (2 Chronicles 7:14) and those who believe in Christ do the same for their country.
- That God strengthen the hearts of the persecuted (Psalm 119:153-161)
- That God uses the persecution and trials to spread the gospel, as He did with the early church (Acts 8:4)
- That those who trust in Jesus will not envy the wicked who prosper, but rather seek God and understand the result of fearing God versus seeking their own gain (Psalm 73)
- That the country will realize that they are relying on their own power and pursuing that which cannot satisfy, and that they turn to Jesus, the source of living water (Jeremiah 2:13)
