Call for Proposals:

We invite faculty and technology professionals to submit proposals that address any of these areas related to transforming language learning as they relate to:

- Research
- Teaching practices
- Instructional design
- Technologies used to transform language learning
- Assessment

Types of Presentations:

NERALLT seeks presentation perspectives and formats that will engage the audience interactively, such as:

- Individual/group presentations (30-minutes +15 min Q & A)
- Round-table discussions or panels (30 minutes, maximum 3 presenters +15 min Q & A)
- Electronic poster sessions
- Workshops (1-2 hours, hands-on)
- Lightning round sessions (5 minute presentation followed by facilitated group discussion)

Guidelines for Proposals:

Proposals should be limited to 300 words. The title should be no longer than 15 words. Only one abstract submission per person, but a presenter may appear as a co-author (but not the first author) on other submitted abstracts. An author may also submit another proposal in an additional category (e.g., a poster or a workshop).
