The color is a light straw yellow with a slight effervescence. The aromas are of under-ripe apples and pears. On the taste, there are tart and sour notes, with hints of dry apple that make us think of a flat sparkling wine.

The color is a deep yellow. The aroma brings notes of light oak, vanilla, and melted butter. On the palate, a vanilla bean custard note really comes through, with some slight oak, and some light notes of fruit bouncing off of smooth, medium body. The finish brings more crème brûlée notes that linger pleasantly.
