Cedars Lodges feature a kitchenette and a private bath.

Cedars 1-6: \$80 per night: 2 queen beds (minimum 4 people, maximum 6 people)

Cedars 7-12: \$120 per night: 3 bedrooms containing 2 double beds, 1 bunk bed and 2 twin beds (minimum 6 people, maximum 8 people)

Rest-A-While Hotel

Rest-A-While Hotel: \$60 per night: 1 double bed, 1 bunk bed, and private bath.

(maximum 4 people per room)

Camp Sites: Available for those who want to bring their tents and camping gear

50amp Camp Site - \$24 per night; 30amp Camp Site - \$15 per night; Drive-In - \$0 per night

Early-Registration Discount

SAVE 10% PLUS \$5 OFF per person (ages 4yrs-adult) by registering by June 1st.

Each registrant ages 4 years-adult who is signed up by June 1st will receive \$5 off their program fee in addition to Cedar Lake's 10% group discount.

\$25 non-refundable registration deposit per person required.

(For example, a family of 4 would require a \$100 registration deposit.)

The deposit will go towards total payment.

If you have a balance, the FINAL payment is due upon arrival on June 30th.

T-shirt sizes are guaranteed for those who register before June 18, 2015.

Final deadline to register with guaranteed t-shirt size is June 16th.
