



Admissions Policy

Admission Philosophy:

“The Cornerstone Christian Academy of Cincinnati, Inc. recruits and admits students of any race, color, national and ethnic origin, and to all the rights, privileges, programs and activities generally accorded or made available to students at the school. In addition, the school will not discriminate on the basis of race, color, national and ethnic origin in the administration of its educational policies, scholarships, loans, fee waivers, educational programs and athletics/extracurricular activities. In addition, the school is not intended to be an alternative to court or administrative agency ordered, or public school district initiated, desegregation.”

Students are admitted and encouraged to participate in all activities without regard to race, color, national or ethnic origin. Any student is admitted when all entrance requirements are met and space is available.

Acceptance to Cornerstone Christian Academy is granted to those who, with their parents, demonstrate a sincere desire to have a Biblically based education. The desire of Cornerstone Christian Academy is to work in partnership with the home and church to provide quality education rooted in Biblical truths and to nurture students as they embrace a personal relationship with Jesus Christ, discover their God-given gifts, seek a plan for their life and serve Him with their mind, body and spirit.

The attendance at CCA is an opportunity granted by the school: it is not a right. It is a privilege that is dependent upon the students adherence to the standards and regulations of CCA, and it is important that the student fit into the spirit of the school as well. The goals of CCA are not to reform, but to help train Christian youth in the principles of Christian leadership, self-discipline, individual responsibility, personal integrity and good citizenship. It is very important that each parent and student read, understand and abide by the principles stated in the Parent/Student Handbook. Failure to do so could cause students to be dismissed from the school.

When selecting Cornerstone Christian Academy, there are some things to keep in mind:

1. Philosophical Considerations:

Cornerstone Christian Academy is a Christian School which provides a Christ-centered, biblically based education. The teachers desire to inspire every student to become a mature follower of Christ. It is advantageous for us to enroll students whose parents have an interest in the school’s spiritual mission.

2. Academic Considerations:

The goal of Cornerstone Christian Academy is to view each child as an individual and to meet each child’s need academically. However, our programs are not all encompassing and may not adequately specialized to meet the special academic or behavioral needs of some students.

3. Financial Considerations: While Cornerstone Christian Academy is sensitive to the various financial circumstances of families, and makes sincere effort to help when possible, it must maintain financial viability. The budget of the school can only be met when parents meet their promised financial commitment to the school. Those who fail to do so will be required to withdraw their children from the school or be denied re-enrollment.
