Casting for Recovery is a national non-profit support and educational program for women who have or have had breast cancer.

We provide an opportunity for women whose lives have been profoundly affected by the disease to gather in a beautiful, natural setting and learn to fly fish, "a sport for life." Just as important, we offer an opportunity to meet new friends and have fun.

Our weekend retreat incorporates counseling, educational services and the sport of fly fishing to promote mental and physical healing.

Founded in 1996, Casting for Recovery has been offering free retreats across the country to help women move forward in their recovery. We rely on local volunteers and organizations to support our community based retreats.

The retreats provide an avenue for social support and group interactions, reducing the feeling of isolation many survivors might have.

The dynamics of fly fishing provide a healing connection to the natural world, relieving every-day stressors and promoting a sense of calm. Fly fishing techniques provide a gentle exercise for joint and soft tissue mobility.

The retreats offer a forum for women with similar experiences to meet, learn a new skill and gain a respite from their everyday concerns in a natural setting where well-being can flourish.

From Ashville:

- 1. Follow I-40 W to TN-162 N/Pellissippi Pkwy.
- 2. Take **Exit 376** for TN-162 N / Pellissippi Pkwy toward Oak Ridge
- 3. Cross the bridge over the river into Oak Ridge
- 4. Use the **right** two lanes to exit onto Bethel Valley Road toward Oak Ridge National Laboratory (the cemetary will be on your right).
- 5. Veer **right** at the traffic light onto Scarboro Rd.
- New Hope Center will be on the left just before the traffic light at Union Valley Rd.
- 7. The sign will say Y-12 East Portal Rd and New Hope Visitors Center

From Nashville:

- 1. Follow I-40 E to TN-58 N/Gallaher Rd
- Take Exit 356 and turn left at the bottom of the ramp. (signs for Oak Ridge/US Dept of Energy/Oak Ridge Natl Lab/Y-12 National Security Complex)
- TN-58 N will turn into Oak Ridge Turnpike/TN-95N and continue to Oak Ridge
- 4. Turn **right** onto **S. Illinois Ave** at traffic light **#12**
- 5. You will pass Ole Ben Franklin Motor s and Bojangles on the right.
- 6. Use the right 2 lanes to turn right onto Scarboro Rd. Stay in the **left lane.**
- 7. Turn **right** at the sign **to Y-12 East Portal/New Hope Visitors Center**.
