

CHEE Field Trip Guidelines

- 1. Cancellations/No Shows** – If you sign up for a field trip and cancel or do not attend for reasons that would be considered avoidable or excusable, you could possibly be removed from the field trip program. Excusable reasons for cancellation include: illness, death in the family, vehicle trouble, and any other unforeseen/common sense situation that prevents you from being able to attend. Please make every effort to make note of field trip dates and times so that you do not forget to attend and risk removal.
- 2. Behavior** – Rules for behavior and dress on field trips are as those listed for those attending CHEE classes. Any damage done to property during a field trip will be the sole responsibility of the parent to replace or rectify. If your child damages something while on a field trip, please discuss with the property owner what action needs to be taken on your part before you leave the premises. Please be respectful of all hosts, tour guides, etc., and follow their instruction and respectfully listen to them while they are speaking.
- 3. Rain** – Field trips that would be affected by rain will be cancelled, and any money paid will be refunded to you on the next CHEE Monday.
- 4. Refunds** – If you cancel or do not attend a trip you are scheduled to attend, your payment for the trip will be given to the person/location/organization who was expecting you. Approved cancellations will be refunded if the Field Trip Coordinator is adequately informed prior to the tour.
- 5. Signups** – Once you have signed your name to the field trip form, the guidelines for cancellations/removal can be applied. If you are unsure that you can attend, please wait to sign up so you will not risk being removed from participating in field trips. Signup deadlines are usually designated for 2 weeks prior to a trip or tour. All payments are due at the time of the signup deadline. Field Trip Signups are conducted at the Information Table or sent to all online from www.signupgenius.com.
- 6. Additional Tours** – If a tour has been filled, it is possible that additional tours can be made. Visit the Info Table to add your name to the list for an additional tour, and if there is enough interest, another tour may be created.
- 7. Arrival Time** – All families should try to arrive **10 minutes prior** to the time of a tour to ensure the tour/activity will not be delayed.
- 8. Common Sense** – With all of the above guidelines, we strive to operate on common sense and prayer. In addition to our weekly meetings, we also want to provide a convenient way to come together for fun and educational trips, and at the same time, respect the time and effort involved for the mom volunteering to organize these trips.

As a group, we may represent many different things, but we should always do our best to reflect Jesus, our families, and the homeschool community in a positive and Christ-like manner. Some of the scheduled activities or trips may not be the best choice for you and your family, so please consider each one in light of whether or not it truly works for you before you sign up.
