

ROUNTON FARM HUNT CLUB SEASON RULES

- 1. Members are required to follow all State and Federal Game laws and Club rules. VIOLATORS WILL BE EXPELLED FROM THE CLUB WITHOUT A REFUND.
- 2. No Smoking on club land during hunting season.
- 3. No alcoholic beverages on club land during hunting season.
- 4. Creating new trails or paths is prohibited without management approval.
- 5. BLAZE ORANGE must be worn at all times on club land.
- 6. No cruising the property during hunting season.
- 7. Bring all concerns to management's attention as soon as possible

8. Sign In policy: All members are required to sign in and affix a sticker on the map on their destination when you enter the property.

9. If you move hunting areas during the day, then you must return and change your sticker on the map. When you are finished you must return and sign out and take your sticker off the map.

10. You must sign in and out in person. You cannot sign in and out at the same time.

11. NO Deer hunting with dogs. No deer dog training allowed on club.

12. Deer hunting is allowed from a stand, blind etc. All day, or stalk hunt from 10 am until 2 pm. You may stalk in your area, open areas or another member's if you have their permission.

13. Scouting is allowed from 10am until 2pm during hunting season, use extreme caution, and show your fellow hunters courtesy.

14. All Hunters are required to spray down with a scent blocker spray before you enter the woods to hunt. In addition, we recommend that you wear scent lock clothing.

15. ON SATURDAYS AND HOLIDAYS, Hunters are required to stay in their stand areas until 10am, and enter your stands by 2pm and stay in your area until dark.

The object of this rule is to prevent hunters from disturbing other hunters when they leave early. If you have an emergency, this rule doesn't apply. If you have a need to leave early, give management a call.
