Griswold Creek Erosion Meeting Scheduled for January 30

Residents interested in learning more about an opportunity to receive financial assistance to address erosion issues along Griswold Creek are encouraged to attend a meeting at 7:00 pm on January 30 at the Russell Historic Town Hall (14890 Chillicothe Road). In late 2012, the Chagrin River Watershed Partners, Inc. (CRWP) was awarded funding from two sources: a Lake Erie Protection Fund grant from the Ohio Lake Erie Commission to complete stream surveys and conceptual stream restoration design and a Great Lakes Basin Program for Soil Erosion and Sediment Control grant to assist landowners with streambank stabilization efforts.
