

- **Search “Your 911” in Google Play (Androids) or the App Store (iPhones)**
 - First app that pops up (in purple)
 - Download the app
 - **Once downloaded** → open the app
 - “swipe to start” → swipe left (3 times)
 - **“Have an emergency? Send your location to first responders” SCREEN**
 - Make sure your Wi-Fi and location services are on
 - Hit “next”
 - **“Select your organization” SCREEN**
 - Search for “Village of Hunting Valley” (listed in alphabetical order)
 - **“Village of Hunting Valley” SCREEN**
 - “select notification group(s)”
 - Check “Resident” box IF...
 - You want to receive city updates
 - Receive emergency alerts for your area
 - i.e. weather notices, tornado warnings, etc.
- **“Where are you currently located?” SCREEN**
 - Hit either “Residence,” “Work,” or “Other”
 - Pop-up says “Is this the correct address?” with the address
 - If you hit “yes”
 - Residence → Pop-up says, “If you have an apt. number, enter it below”
 - Work → Pop-up says, “What is the business name”
 - Other → Pop-up says, “Enter the name of your location”
 - If you hit “no” → takes you to another screen “Your 911” to add the address manually
- **“Registration” SCREEN**
 - ***Enter basic information in***
 - First name
 - Last name
 - Mobile device #
 - Create secure pin # (4-digits)
 - Re-enter secure pin
 - ***“Add Friend Watch Contact”***
 - Click on “Contact #1”
 - Pop-up asking to access your contact list
 - Hit “Allow”
 - Select contact for your Friend Watch feature
 - You will be able to select two more later on in registration
 - Hit “Continue”

- **“Terms of services and end user license agreement” SCREEN**
 - Pop-up says, “Your 911 would like to send you notifications”
 - Select “Allow” or “Don’t Allow”
 - Check the “Accept Terms and conditions” box on bottom
 - Hit “accept”

- **“Hunting Valley” SCREEN**
 - ***Icons pop up***
 - Emergency
 - Tips
 - FriendWatch
 - Calendar of Events
 - Services
 - ***On the bottom...***
 - Bell Icon
 - Profile Icon
 - Share Icon

- **Emergency button**
 - 9-1-1 → Not only one click away, but one button away!
 - Button is hit → calls the closest responders and sends them your contact information, location and medical information

- **Tips**
 - **iReports:**
 - most commonly used feature of the app
 - can be used for emergency and non-emergencies
 - send videos, pictures and text (no character limit)
 - option to send anonymously
 - if you see something suspicious → you can report it
 - report city affairs such as trees down, areas with bad roads (big pothole), etc.

- **FriendWatch**
 - Once clicked → ask you to describe your activity (i.e.: jogging, walking somewhere alone at night, etc.)
 - “Select End Time” → How long it’s going to take you to do the activity
 - Minimum: 5 minutes
 - Maximum: 2 hours
 - “Start timer” button is pushed
 - The person doing the activity will have to enter their PIN # (4-digit code at registration) before the timer is up, or the 3 contacts they added to their FriendWatch list will be notified via text

- **Calendar**
 - Clicking on this icon takes you directly to the Hunting Valley Calendar of Events webpage
 - Keeps you updated on community events

- **Services-Village Hall**
 - Hit "Services" icon
 - You will see two icons come up
 - "Contact Village Hall"
 - Icon gives you the option to directly contact Village Hall without remembering or having to look up the number
 - The other icon is the map, located on the next slide

- **Services-Map**
 - The next icon under "services"
 - Gives you a map of the area

- **When Your 911 is first opened → Screen pops up with all the icons**
 - On the bottom, there's three
 - **Bell Icon:** Notifications
 - **Profile Icon** – This is where you can go to add your date of birth, physical description, photo of yourself, two more contacts to your FriendWatch Contact List, your medical information, as well as other locations
 - **Share Icon** – allows you to share the apps with others
