

## NOTICE

NOTICE is hereby given that Springfield Township, York County, Pennsylvania will, at its regular public meeting on Monday, October 14, 2019, at 8:15 p.m., at the Municipal Building at 9211 Susquehanna Trail South, Seven Valleys, Pennsylvania, 17360, consider for adoption an Ordinance entitled **“AN ORDINANCE OF SPRINGFIELD TOWNSHIP, YORK COUNTY, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, ELECTING TO AMEND ITS NON-UNIFORM PENSION PLAN ADMINISTERED BY THE PENNSYLVANIA MUNICIPAL RETIREMENT SYSTEM PURSUANT TO ARTICLE IV OF THE PENNSYLVANIA MUNICIPAL RETIREMENT LAW; AGREEING TO BE BOUND BY ALL PROVISIONS OF THE PENNSYLVANIA MUNICIPAL RETIREMENT LAW AS AMENDED AND AS APPLICABLE TO MEMBER MUNICIPALITIES.”** Section I of the Ordinance authorizes an amendment to the Township pension plan in accordance with applicable Pennsylvania law. Section II authorizes the Pennsylvania Municipal Retirement System to administer the Township pension plan. Section III acknowledges passage of the ordinance amending the Township Plan to an In-Service Distribution Plan. Section IV obligates the Township to make payment on its obligations in the pension plan. Section V is a severability clause. Section VI states the Township shall file a certified copy of the Ordinance and contract with the system. A copy of the proposed Ordinance is available for inspection at this newspaper and the Township Office during normal business hours.

**AN ORDINANCE OF SPRINGFIELD TOWNSHIP, YORK COUNTY,  
COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, ELECTING TO AMEND ITS  
NON-UNIFORM PENSION PLAN ADMINISTERED BY THE  
PENNSYLVANIA MUNICIPAL RETIREMENT SYSTEM PURSUANT TO  
ARTICLE IV OF THE PENNSYLVANIA MUNICIPAL RETIREMENT LAW;  
AGREEING TO BE BOUND BY ALL PROVISIONS OF THE  
PENNSYLVANIA MUNICIPAL RETIREMENT LAW AS AMENDED AND  
AS APPLICABLE TO MEMBER MUNICIPALITIES. IT IS HEREBY  
ORDAINED BY SPRINGFIELD TOWNSHIP, YORK COUNTY,  
PENNSYLVANIA AS FOLLOWS:**

**WHEREAS**, Springfield Township (“Township”) is a duly organized second class township; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Pennsylvania Second Class Township Code (“Code”) authorizes the Board of Supervisors to establish and amend pensions as a benefit of the Township’s employees pursuant to Code Section 1512(e) and the Pennsylvania Municipal Retirement Law, 53 P.S. section 881.101, et seq; and,

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to such authority, the Township has heretofore established a Pension for its employees with the Pennsylvania Municipal Retirement System on January 1, 2001 and, from time to time, amended the Pension; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Supervisors deem it appropriate to amend the Springfield Township Pension Plan.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED** as follows:

**SECTION I.** Springfield Township (the Township), having established a non-uniform pension plan administered by the Pennsylvania Municipal Retirement System (the System), hereby elects to amend its Non-Uniform Pension Plan administered by the System in accordance with Article IV of the Pennsylvania Municipal Retirement Law, 53 P.S. §881.101 et seq. (Retirement Law), and does hereby agree to be bound by all the requirements and provisions of the Retirement Law and the Municipal Pension Plan Funding Standard and Recovery Act, 53 P.S. §895.101 et seq., and to assume all obligations, financial and otherwise, placed upon member municipalities.

**SECTION II.** As part of this Ordinance, the Township agrees that the System shall administer and provide the benefits set forth in the amended Non-Uniform Pension Plan Document

entered into between the Pennsylvania Municipal Retirement Board and the Township effective as of the date specified in the adoption agreement (the Contract).

**SECTION III.** The Township acknowledges that by passage and adoption of this Ordinance, the Township officially accepts the Contract and the financial obligations resulting from the administration of the Contract.

**SECTION IV.** Payment for any obligation established by the adoption of this Ordinance and the Contract shall be made by the Township in accordance with the Retirement Law and the Municipal Pension Plan Funding Standard and Recovery Act. The Township hereby assumes all liability for any unfundedness created due to the benefit structure set forth in the Contract.

**SECTION V.** The Township intends this Ordinance to be the complete authorization of the Contract, as amended and it shall become effective as of the date specified in the adoption agreement, which is the effective date of the Contract, as amended.

**SECTION VI.** A duly certified copy of this Ordinance and an executed Contract shall be filed with the System.
