### **GENERAL INFORMATION & POLICIES**

The purpose of K9-5 Doggie Daycare Center (“Center”) is to provide a safe, fun and stimulating social environment for dogs during weekday business hours. To ensure the safety and health of your pet and our other guests, we require all guests to comply with the following rules and regulations:

**AGE:** All dogs must be at least 12 weeks of age or older.

**SEX:** All dogs 7 months or older must be spayed or neutered.

**SHOTS:** All dogs must have up-to-date vaccinations. Owners must submit written proof of DHLPP and Bordetella vaccinations. Rabies is required for puppies over 4 months of age.

**HEALTH:** All dogs must be in good health. Owners will certify their dog(s) are in good health and have not been ill with a communicable condition in the last 3 days. Upon admission, all dogs must be free from any condition that could potentially jeopardize other guests. Dogs that have been ill with a communicable condition in the last 7 days will require veterinarian certification of health to be admitted or readmitted.

**BEHAVIOR:** All dogs must be non-aggressive and not food or toy protective. Owners will certify their dogs have not harmed or shown any aggressive or threatening behavior towards any person or any other dog(s). Please remember: your pet will be spending time with other pets and the safety and health of all animals is our main concern.

**APPLICATION:** All dogs must have a complete, up-to-date and approved application on file. There is a one-time, \$25.00 non-refundable application screening fee for each pet.

**FEES:** Fees are based on a pass plan. A pass is valid for 3 months from date of purchase. Additional dogs are \$15.00 per day, per dog.

1-Day Pass:	\$25
5-Day Pass:	\$115 (\$23 per day)
10-Day Pass:	\$200 (\$20 per day)
Additional dogs:	\$15 per day per additional dog

**DAYS AND HOURS:** Monday through Friday from 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. The Center is not an overnight facility. Staff goes off duty at 6:00 p.m. and there is a \$1.00 per minute charge for any pet left after 6:00 p.m.

**RESERVATIONS:** Required. Cancellations with less than 24 hours notice will be charged full fees.
