- Must be a graduating senior planning on attending a junior college or university; or a full time college student carrying 12 units or more.
- Must have a grade point average of 2.5 or better.
- Must be <u>ONE</u> of the following:
  - 1. A child or grandchild of a Ventura County Cattlemen's Association member OR,
  - 2. A current member of the Ventura County Young Cattlemen's Association OR,
  - 3. An active member of one of the following organizations: FFA, 4-H, or Grange <u>AND</u> entered to show any livestock animal at the 2015 Ventura County Fair.

### **Requirements:**

- Application is to be typewritten
- Must submit one letter of recommendation.
- Must submit a sealed certified copy of your most current high school or college transcripts.
- Must submit an essay typewritten or word-processed (no smaller than 10 point type), 500 to 700 words. Include the last four numbers of your social security number as identification, in the top right hand corner.

### Selection:

- In determining scholarship recipients the Scholarship Committee will base selection upon the following criteria:
  - Scholastic standing

- Leadership, citizenship, and extra curricular activities, number of hours worked within and/or outside the agriculture/livestock industry, including involvement in Young Cattlemen's Association, FFA, 4-H, and Grange.
- Agricultural Major preferred, but not required
  The creativity, depth of thought, and insight articulated in an essay explaining the issues affecting agriculture, particularly the cattle industry.
- Neatness and thoroughness of application.

Scholarship recipients will be notified no later than May 12, 2015. Recipients will be presented with their scholarship award at the Ventura County Cattlemen's Board Meeting on **May 19, 2015**.
