General Show Information and Rules

Fees for Open Shows are:

\$5 Office Fee

\$8 per class or \$60 All Day for KHOA Members. \$50 if pre-registered.

\$10 per class or \$75 All Day for non-members. \$65 if pre-registered.

\$10 Late Fee if entered after 10pm the Thursday before the show or on site.

KHOA Membership Fees: \$15 Individual or \$25 Family

Open checks are highly encouraged. KHOA will not issue refunds.

Classes are divided into age/experience groups. Large classes may be split and small classes may be combined at the discretion of the Show Secretary/Show Committee.

Ribbons will be awarded for 1st – 6th place. Prizes will be awarded for High Point in each Division.

Basic definitions of skill level:

Maiden – Horse/Rider has not won 3rd or better in division being shown. IE: New to showing, beginner, green.

Novice – Horse/Rider has not won (3) 1st place ribbons in division being shown. IE: Novice or Intermediate rider/horse is comfortable riding and can execute basic maneuvers. May have shown some or taken lessons.

Open – Horse/Rider is an experienced or advanced rider/horse.

Class levels are based on the experience level of horse or rider or both as a team. These classes/divisions are split so that those new to showing can have fun, learn, and be competitive with their peers. Please enter in the classes that you feel are suited to your skill level and that of your horse. If an Open level rider that has earned several points enters into a Maiden class, they will not be judged. You are welcome to ride as "non-judged" in any class/division but please place your number upside down so that the Judge is aware.

Cross Entering: You may <u>not</u> cross enter from walk/trot(jog) only into loping/cantering classes and vice versa. To observe fairness in the calculation of points – if you are found cross entering, you will be disqualified from both divisions. Formal show attire is not required but appropriate saddle must be ridden in each division.

English classes may be shown in hunt, dressage, flat, or all-purpose saddle.

Training aids (martingales, draw reins) are allowed.

You may ride two handed in a one handed bit (or vice versa) but you may not switch from two to one hand during a class.

Abusive, excessive "training" will not be tolerated and exhibitor may be asked to leave the premises, forfeiting all monies paid to KHOA.

Anyone exhibiting unsportsmanlike conduct will be asked to leave the premises.

The Show Secretary/Show Committee has the right to combine, split, cancel, and/or stop any class for any reason.

The Judge may stop or hold the class at their discretion.
